
Testimony. Some scholars claim that the testimony of the women which the other disciples accepted is the basis of the faith on the resurrection story of Jesus. However, ASCENCION commands the disciples this time, to get out of Jerusalem and be re-united with Him in Galilee. Therefore, It is the testimonial encounter that sparked the hope of the frightened and confused disciples in fulfilling the work of Christ. Take Courage. Perseverance in good works. *What faith story changed our lives?*



Worship. It is also noticeable in the gospel account, how the disciples reacted not by amazement, fascination, and curiosity, but by *remaining in worship*, amidst doubts, skepticism, suspicions, objections, fear of people. Therefore, even after the Resurrection, lack of faith was present amongst His disciples. *How do we glorify God?*

Commissioning. Like in the transfiguration, God comes to our assistance. God did not come to address the angels and perfect believers; Jesus comes to us to do one thing: TO SPEAK to troubled hearts. Teach them to sacrifice their wants and desires, and begin to give way no longer to the believers but also to the gentiles. *The theological literal interpretation* of the gospel of Matthew regarding church mission is no longer to a few, but to make disciples of all nations. Baptizing, teaching, and assuring them of God's presence. *Are we a welcoming community?*


¿Qué historia de fe ha cambiado nuestras vidas?

Nombramiento – Como en la transfiguración, Dios viene a asistirnos. Dios no vino a dirigirse a los ángeles y discípulos perfectos. Jesús viene a hacer una cosa: a hablar a los corazones inquietos. Les enseña a sacrificar sus anhelos y deseos, y comienza a ceder el paso no solamente a los creyentes, sino también a los gentiles. *La interpretación teológica literal* del Evangelio de Mateo, con respecto a la misión de la iglesia no es más para los pocos, sino para convertir a todas las naciones en discípulos. Bautizando, enseñando, y asegurando a todos de la presencia de Dios. *¿Somos una comunidad acogedora?*

Gospel Meditation For Your Day

“A pair of ducks found their way to the same little corner of the property year after year. Sheltered by a little grove of trees, they quickly made their preparations to build a nest, lay eggs, and welcome in a new family. Then one year, only one of the ducks came to that little corner. She went about the business of building a nest, but this time, she was clearly unsettled. She would wander around, sometimes seemingly without purpose, almost hoping perhaps that her mate might come along. But, she remained alone. There were many times when we could hear her “crying”, mourning her loneliness and lack of purpose, sitting on a batch of eggs that would never hatch. One day, she quietly left that little corner never to return again.

Many human beings approach life this way. We silently grieve our loneliness, lack of direction, and sense of purpose. Maybe life once had meaning for us, but nothing seems to claim us and settle our restlessness any longer. We wander around looking and hoping for someone or something to come our way. We may even sob at times, wailing as we sit with the misery of our pain. Will happiness ever come our way again? Or will we simply leave where we are never to return again? Many are lost, wandering souls who are not quite sure where to settle or where to make a home.

We are meant to be in Christ. This glorious feast of the Ascension shows us, with clear vision, who Jesus really is! Return To All Souls 8:30 am Weekday Masses

Welcome back! All Souls has been praying and preparing for your return. By God's grace, and at the direction of Bishop Noonan, we are now welcoming you back to Weekday Masses at the Church on SR 46. Masses will be familiar, but a few changes have been made within the church for your health and safety. Here are the new things to know...

- Please wash your hands before Mass... your health and that of your neighbor is our greatest concern
- Church staff or ushers will be available to help direct you to your seats. Please wait for their signals and directions
- Outside and inside the church, you'll see marks on the floor indicating 6 ft social distancing
- Inside the church, you'll see some pews or sections marked with "X's". That means "don't sit there"
- Only every other pew will be in use, in order to maintain social distancing when seated
- Please be sure to sit 6 ft apart as indicated. However, household members may sit together
- Face masks are recommended for those over age 10. Church staff will all be wearing face masks
- During the "Sign of Peace" and "Our Father", please refrain from touching. A simple wave or bow will do
- Hand sanitizers are available in the church. Please consider bringing your own for use at Communion
- During Communion, please *stand* at your seat and wait for a Eucharistic Minister to come to you
- Remove your face mask; cup your hands; receive the Host in your palm; consume the Host; then replace your mask
- After Mass, church staff will motion you to exit your pew. Please be patient so we can maintain social distancing
- Please exit the church right after Mass, so that cleaning and sanitizing can immediately begin

Entering and Exiting the Church:

- Only the front doors of the church will be opened for Mass. The side doors will remain closed*
- *If you have a disability, the side-door on the East will be opened to allow access from the handicap parking. Staff will be on hand
- The church doors will open ½ hour before Mass, and close right after Mass. Prayer time is very limited
- As you approach the entrance, there'll be 3 lanes indicated. The center lane is reserved for those with disabilities
- Signage will help indicate restroom locations, so you can line up accordingly. Read other signage for more info
- Offertory boxes (blue) are located near the doors, for your use upon entering or leaving the church
- Please refrain from gathering or socializing in groups outside the church; prior to, or after Mass

Thank you for your attention to the new procedures that have been developed for your well-being. Although some things have changed, Our Lord's house and Eucharistic celebration are still the same, and His grace is always with us. Please know that we will be live-streaming our Masses on the All Souls Website, for those who cannot physically join us. El Regreso de las Misas Semanales a las 8:30am

¡Bienvenidos de vuelta! Nuestra iglesia All Souls ha estado orando y preparándose para su regreso. Por la gracia de Dios, y bajo la dirección del Obispo Noonan, nosotros estamos ahora preparados para bienveniros de regreso a las Misas Semanales en la iglesia en la SR 46. Las misas van a ser similares, pero con unos pocos cambios que se han hecho en la iglesia para su salud y su seguridad. Aquí están las cosas nuevas que deben saber:

- Por favor, lávense las manos antes de ir a la Misa...su salud y la de las personas alrededor suyo son nuestra mayor preocupación.
- El personal y los ujieres van a estar disponibles para dirigirlos a sus asientos. Por favor esperen por las señales y direcciones.
- Afuera y adentro de la iglesia, usted verá las marcas en el piso indicando los 6 pies de distanciamiento social.
- Dentro de la iglesia, usted verá algunos bancos o secciones marcados con una "X". Esto significa "no se siente ahí"
- Cada otro banco será usado, en orden de mantener el distanciamiento social cuando estén sentados.
- Por favor asegúrese de sentarse a 6 pies de separación. Sin embargo, los miembros de familia se pueden sentar juntos.
- Las mascarillas faciales son recomendadas para las personas mayores de 10 años. El personal de la iglesia tendrá puestas las mascarillas faciales.
- Durante "La Señal de la Paz" y "El Padre Nuestro", por favor absténganse de tocar a las personas. Un simple gesto con la mano o una pequeña reverencia es suficiente.
- Los desinfectantes para las manos estarán disponibles en la iglesia. Por favor consideren en traer el suyo propio para usarlo durante la Comunión.
- Durante la Comunión, por favor póngase de pie en su asiento y espere que el ministro de la Eucaristía vaya hacia usted.
- Remueva su mascarilla facial; ponga sus manos en forma de copa; reciba la Hostia Sagrada en su palma; consuma la Hostia; entonces vuelva a ponerse la mascarilla facial.
- Después de Misa, el personal de la iglesia le va a señalar cuando debe salir de su banco. Por favor sea paciente para que nosotros podamos mantener el distanciamiento social.
- Por favor salga de la iglesia directamente después de la Misa, para que podamos limpiar y desinfectar de inmediato.

Entrando y Saliendo de la Iglesia

- Sólo las puertas de la entrada de la iglesia estarán abiertas para la Misa. Las puertas laterales estarán cerradas.*
- *Si usted tiene alguna discapacidad, la puerta lateral en el Este estará abierta para permitir acceso del estacionamiento de discapacitados. Habrá personal de la iglesia para ayudar.
- Las puertas de la iglesia abrirán ½ hora antes de la Misa, y cerrarán justo después de la Misa. El tiempo de oración es muy limitado.
- A medida que se acerque a la entrada, se indicarán 3 carriles. El carril del centro está reservado para los que tengan discapacidades.
- Los letreros le ayudarán a encontrar los baños, para que puedan hacer la línea como corresponde. Lean los letreros para más información.
- Las cajas de ofertorio (azules) estarán ubicadas cerca de las puertas, para su uso al entrar o al salir de la iglesia.
- Por favor absténganse de reunirse y socializar en grupos a las afueras de la iglesia; antes y después de Misa.

Gracias por su atención sobre todos los nuevos procedimientos que se han hecho para su bienestar. Aunque algunas cosas han cambiado, la Casa de Nuestro Señor y la celebración de la Eucaristía es la misma, y Su gracia siempre está con nosotros. Por favor sepan que estaremos transmitiendo en vivo nuestras Misas en el sitio web de All Souls para los que no puedan estar físicamente con nosotros. St. Bede the Venerable



(c. 672 - May 25, 735)

Bede is one of the few saints honored as such even during his lifetime. His writings were filled with such faith and learning that even while he was still alive, a Church council ordered them to be read publicly in the churches.

At an early age, Bede was entrusted to the care of the abbot of the Monastery of St. Paul, Jarrow. The happy combination of genius and the instruction of scholarly, saintly monks, produced a saint and an extraordinary scholar, perhaps the most outstanding one of his day. He was deeply versed in all the sciences of his times: natural philosophy, the philosophical principles of Aristotle, astronomy, arithmetic, grammar, ecclesiastical history, the lives of the saints and especially, holy Scripture.

From the time of his ordination to the priesthood at 30—he had been ordained a deacon at 19—till his death, Bede was ever occupied with learning, writing, and teaching. Besides the many books that he copied, he composed 45 of his own, including 30 commentaries on books of the Bible.

His *Ecclesiastical History of the English People* is commonly regarded as of decisive importance in the art and science of writing history. A unique era was coming to an end at the time of Bede's death: It had fulfilled its purpose of preparing Western Christianity to assimilate the non-Roman barbarian North. Bede recognized the opening to a new day in the life of the Church even as it was happening.

Although eagerly sought by kings and other notables, even Pope Sergius, Bede managed to remain in his own monastery until his death. Only once did he leave for a few months in order to teach in the school of the archbishop of York. Bede died in 735 praying his favorite prayer: "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As in the beginning, so now, and forever."




Spending your time cleaning out your house/garage? Maybe we can use your never used or gently used items for the Harvest
