

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

THE IMPORTANCE TO FOLLOW NOW NOT LATER.

Last week we hear how the Lord called Samuel and how he responded, "speak Lord your servant is listening." The calling set the tone in Paul's letter to the Corinthian's to morality while sharing to us the vocation story of Andrew and Peter's role in building Christ's community of faith.

Have you ever heard of people's stories of their own vocations? Discerning if not struggling against or towards one's vocation in life is not an extra ordinary phenomenon. Until now, even after 30 years of priesthood, God continue to surprise me as I discover His invitation to open up His kingdom to all people. Have you really examined the different options of your vocation? Have you lived your vocation faithfully in the last 2, 3, 10 years of life?

"How beautiful are the feet that proclaims the good news of God to the people."

In today's gospel we continue the theme on Vocations. How Jesus and John introduces the new messianic age to the people. We witness how both John and Jesus focusing on the right time to work by preaching God's reign to rule and save the world. Not to bring trouble to the world, but redemption by changing the way of thinking, acting, and believing the good news ready to break into our lives. The account of the calling of the 1st four disciples testifies to their vocation, and now being handed over to us.

As Jesus went after all people who live in the darkness of sin and death, so we see our vocation taking its position in proclaiming REPENTANCE AND FORGIVENESS SINS by turning ourselves to the caller who is passing by our lives each moment a of our lives. St Paul speaks about the urgency to come after Jesus and follow Him.

For the importance to answer the Lord is not about time but about what we do now to determine our future. Now is critical. Now Is Good. Come let us follow our master's calling.


"Cuán hermosos son los pies que proclaman las buenas nuevas de Dios al pueblo".

Gospel Meditation For Your Day

"It was a normal day by all accounts, but John just wasn't feeling himself. He was a little lightheaded and out of sorts. Later in the afternoon, he experienced a sharp pain in his chest and arm. Quick thinking and action brought John to the emergency department with a diagnosis of a significant heart attack. Surviving this ordeal, he found himself face to face with his cardiologist, having an honest conversation about things that needed to change. "I came close to death," John found himself thinking. Then came the remorse. He was a young man with a loving wife and children who were very close to facing life without him. John found himself with intense sorrow for living an unchecked and self-indulgent life that almost brought him to his demise. He wanted to change.

We all have our wake-up calls. We have experiences and encounters that force us to really think twice about choices we have made and directions we have taken. Often, we find ourselves looking at those we have hurt square in the eye and wallowing in our foolishness. We regrettably realize that we have allowed our needs to lure us into making some cruel mistakes. We impulsively say things and flippantly do things that reveal our unredeemed and unhealed self. It is a self we stumble over and try to tame but can't quite seem to master and control. Help!

We spin our wheels, naively thinking that we will somehow, perhaps through persistence, get ourselves unstuck. But, we don't. We just get out of the car, feeling very helpless, and ignorantly look at the mess we got ourselves into. Did we ever think to ask someone for help? Or, taken the advice of One who is wiser and avoid this route altogether? "Come after me," are words that Jesus

says to all of us. In order to heed his invitation, we must leave our ego-self behind and follow.

When we really see and understand the freedom, peace, justice, and love he offers, we find ourselves with such sorrow in our hearts for how foolish and silly we have been. All the misguided choices and sinful actions come full view and we see how risky our random impassioned behaviors really have been. Repentance is beautiful. When done with a sincere and contrite heart, it directs us to the glory that can be ours, ignites us with the challenge of living a life in service of others and reminds us that all is well. ©LPi

Lent is Approaching, Let's Prepare Drawing Closer to God



Our faith journey is full of wonders and lessons, each one serving as a way for us to recommit our lives to God. This renewed commitment includes understanding our feasts and celebrations; it means knowing a little about the precious history and rich traditions of the Catholic Church and preparing to observe these time-honored rituals of Advent, Lent, the Holy Triduum, Easter, and Divine Mercy Sunday.

These traditions are particularly important as Ash Wednesday approaches, and we face the task of preparing for our Lenten journey. Lent is a time of spiritual renewal and purification, a season that allows us to draw closer to Christ and ready ourselves to recognize his sacrifice on the cross and his conquering of death.

There are many ways to prepare for Lent. Prayer and meditation, fasting and sacrifice, generosity with our fellow man, are all paths that we can follow to draw closer to God. We invite you to follow this series and set your course toward the Light of Christ, as we embark on our individual and collective Lenten journey as children of God.

Saint Francis de Sales



(August 21, 1567 – December 28, 1622)

Francis was destined by his father to be a lawyer and eventually take his elder's place as a senator in France. For this reason Francis was sent to Padua to study law. After receiving his doctorate, he returned home and, in due time, told his parents he wished to enter the priesthood. His father strongly opposed Francis in this, and only after much patient persuasiveness on the part of the gentle Francis did his father finally consent. Francis was ordained and elected provost of the Diocese of Geneva, then a center for the Calvinists. Francis set out to convert them by preaching and distributing little pamphlets he wrote to explain true Catholic doctrine, he had remarkable success.

At 35, he became bishop of Geneva. While administering his diocese he continued to preach, hear confessions, and catechize the children. His gentle character was a great asset in winning souls. He practiced his own axiom, "A spoonful of honey attracts more flies than a barrelful of vinegar."

Besides his two well-known books, the Introduction to the Devout Life and A Treatise on the Love of God, he wrote many pamphlets and carried on a vast correspondence. For his writings, he has been named patron of the Catholic Press. His writings, filled with his characteristic gentle spirit, are addressed to lay people. He wants to make them understand that they too are called to be saints.

In spite of his busy and comparatively short life, he had time to collaborate with another saint, Jane Frances de Chantal, in the work of establishing the Sisters of the Visitation. These women were to practice the virtues exemplified in Mary's visit to Elizabeth: humility, piety, and mutual charity. They at first engaged to a limited degree in works of mercy for the poor and the sick. Today, while some communities conduct schools, others live a strictly contemplative life.
