*...tongues as of fire*

Before Sylvester, our seminarian, left for seminary, we had the chance to grab lunch together. I thought of a local health food store, not sure if they had a lunch counter or not, and asked if we should try there. Sylvester, always ready for adventure, said "Yes, God's will be done."

We found our way to the back of the store where a little lunch counter was in fact serving healthy sandwiches and soups and salads. As we were ordering, a short, older man engaged us, asking, "Are you believers?" I responded, "Yes, we try." He, jumping into the air and throwing his hands over his head, shouted, "Fire!!" We were surprised, but humored, at such a welcome. He went on to share his faith with us, even running out to his car to get us a few special prayers that he knew of. Sylvester loves an adventure.


I do to. When I was just 4 years old I began adventuring with a friend down the block. We would walk around the block thinking of where we had never been before. One day, seeing a block we had never explored, I declared, "Let's go on an adventure." Everything was new. New houses, new plants, new view of the sky above. There was even a new foundation for a house being built, which upon inspection, held a few big frogs begging for escape.

Having enough of big frogs, we continued down the block, when much to my surprise, my mom, in our big station wagon, was slowing down as she passed. I could see the ominous sight of my brother and sister laughing at me from the back seat. I knew this meant trouble. The one thing that could really humor them was me getting into trouble. I think my backside is still sore from that one. No more adventures for awhile.

"Fire!" Nothing spells adventure like Pentecost. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit might be intimidating for some. We don't know what will happen. We don't know how God will use us. And yet, we as Catholic Christians are anointed with the Holy Spirit in a special way through the Sacrament of Confirmation. Most of us are confirmed, but do we live in the gifts of the Holy Spirit?

You are gifted for the sharing of the Gospel in some unique way. Only you can live your gifts with your particular personality. You may have the same gift as others (i.e. Encouragement, Music, Service, Administration, Alms, Teaching...etc.), but the expression is of course unique in you. Why not fulfill in life what only you can do?

We each have a mission. St. John Newman says it this way:



*God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission. I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good; I shall do His work. I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place, while not intending it, if I do but keep His commandments. Therefore, I will trust Him; whatever I am, I can never be thrown away. If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve Him; in perplexity, my perplexity may serve Him. If I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve Him. He does nothing in vain. He knows what He is about. He may take away my friends. He may throw me among strangers. He may make me feel desolate, make my spirits sink, hide my future from me. Still, He knows what He is about.*

God is trustworthy. Do not be afraid of the Holy Spirit.



# A PRAYER TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

On the feast of Pentecost, May 23, Archbishop Paul D. Etienne will promulgate a new pastoral plan for the Archdiocese of Seattle. The archbishop invites Catholics to pray a novena to the Holy Spirit leading up to Pentecost (May 14–22), for the intention of the renewal and spread of the faith. The novena prayer is a translation of the traditional Pentecost hymn *Veni Creator Spiritus*.


