May the peace of the Risen Christ be with you all. I pray for you and look forward to meeting you all soon in my transition as your new pastor of our parish family in Renton starting July 1, 2024. I recently met with your current priests and parish staffs following a joint mass the end of May. I look forward to serving with Fr. Sylvester Chanda, and Fr. Marlo Abad. Fr. Chanda and I will live at St. Anthony and Fr. Marlo will live at St. Stephens. Fr. Gilberto Mora Tapia will also help at times along with parishes in Kent and Tacoma.

I realize with partners in the Gospel and becoming a new parish family many still have various questions. Sadness of losing departing priests, energy to welcome new priests, AND slowly over time collaborating as parishes in our new family structure will all take time, so I encourage you all just to be faithful and flexible (and patient). I will be at both parishes



as your pastor equally as best I am able. If we trust the Holy Spirit and remain focused on Jesus all will be well. We are the largest parish family in the archdiocese; just think of all the good we can do together to share the joy of the Gospel, grow in holiness, and build the kingdom of God!

I am returning home. I was baptized at St. Paul parish, and then we moved to Cascade Vista where I attended Tiffany Park, Nelsen and Lindbergh H.S. (class of 1993). We were regular parishioners at St. Stephen and would occasionally attend mass at St. Anthony depending on schedules. Many of my friends attended St. Anthony school growing up. My family moved out of the area to Seattle, and I attended Western Washington University earning a teaching degree in History and Language Arts. I served as a teacher and missionary before entering seminary as a Dominican. After four years of formation, I discerned to return home to the Archdiocese of Seattle and was ordained in 2006.

As a priest I have served as a parochial vicar in Tacoma, priest administrator in Issaquah, Vocation Director, chaplain at Kennedy Catholic High School, parish priest at St. Benedict, St. Mary and for a time St. Anthony in Renton. I am completing three years as pastor at Holy Family Kirkland.

I also serve the archdiocese on the priest personnel board, *Partners in the Gospel* oversight committee, mentor for first time pastors, instructor for the deacon formation program, and recently finished my Doctor of Ministry from Mount Angel Seminary.

I will pray for you and ask you to pray for all parish families and priests during this time of transition. I look forward to praying with you and greeting you all very soon.

Respect Life June 24th marked the two-year anniversary of the Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, which overturned Roe v. Wade. As we approach this anniversary, we continue to thank God that states can once again protect the lives of pre-born children in law. Since the Dobbs decision, many states have enacted strong legal protections for pre-born children. Tragically, other states have drastically expanded abortion access, such as Kansas, Michigan, and Ohio, due in part to deceptive campaigns and advertising. Other states continue to pursue extreme, pro-abortion policies. This fall, as many as 10 states will have abortion referenda on their ballots, enabling voters to enshrine abortion and override existing pro-life safeguards in the process. At this critical moment, whether we reside in states with pro-life or pro-abortion policies, we are presented with opportunities and responsibilities to continue building a culture that welcomes, celebrates, and protects human life. Our prayers are essential to maintaining policies that protect life, where they exist, and preventing the spread of policies that lead to more abortions. Let us draw close to Christ's Sacred Heart and sincerely ask how he is calling us to use our unique gifts for the cause of life.


