

Reflect: The Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization overturned Roe v. Wade, ending the nearly fifty-year reign of nationwide abortion on demand. Dobbs returned the issue of abortion to the people's elected representatives at the federal and state levels. Since the Dobbs decision, many states have enacted strong legal protections for preborn children. Tragically, other states have drastically expanded abortion. In the most recent election, ten states featured ballot initiatives that would enshrine abortion in state constitutions, with seven of them voting in favor of abortion and overriding pro-life safeguards in the process. ... 
