#### Washington Bishops Ask Federal Court to Block Law That Breaks Seal of Confession

SEATTLE — The Roman Catholic bishops of Washington state asked a federal court late Thursday to block a new state law that forces priests to break the sacred seal of confession or face jail time before the law takes effect on July 27. This legal action follows a lawsuit the bishops filed May 29 against the state of Washington. They say the new law — which requires clergy to report abuse if shared within the sacred confines of the confessional — violates religious freedom protections in the U.S. Constitution. The lawsuit also notes that the clergy-penitent privilege is singled out in the law, but protections remain for lawyers and their clients. The Catholic Church already requires priests to report abuse and neglect to law enforcement and other state authorities — with the only exception for information learned during the sacrament of confession....
