Know Our Two New Saints

The two most recently recognized Catholic saints are St. Carlo Acutis and St. Pier Giorgio Frassati, both Italian laymen, who were canonized on September 7, 2025. Carlo Acutis was a young, tech-savvy Italian who died in 2006 and is known for using his computer skills to spread his faith, while Pier Giorgio Frassati was an avid outdoorsman who died of polio in 1925.

Saint Carlo Acutis is the first millennial to be canonized as a saint and is sometimes called the "patron saint of the internet" or "God's Influencer" for using his technological skills to create websites for the Catholic Church and his parish.

Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati was an Italian student and avid outdoorsman known for his deep faith and social activism, often caring for the poor and sick.
