Based on the survey responses across all parishes, here are some **common themes** that emerged in the categories of spiritual impact, parish gifts, favorite aspects, and parish pride:

Spiritual Impact

Across parishes, many respondents shared that:

- Adoration and prayer have deepened their relationship with God.
- **Participation in ministries** (e.g., food pantry, lector, Eucharistic minister) has strengthened their faith.
- Homilies and Mass attendance provide spiritual nourishment and clarity.
- **Community support** and kindness from fellow parishioners have made them feel welcomed and spiritually uplifted.

1 Parish Gifts

Commonly mentioned gifts and charisms include:

- Welcoming and inclusive communities that embrace diversity.
- Active ministries that offer opportunities for service and spiritual growth.
- **Strong Eucharistic devotion**, including 24/7 Adoration.
- Vibrant liturgical life, with music, homilies, and sacraments that resonate deeply.

Favorite Aspects

Parishioners frequently highlighted:

- Sense of belonging and family within the parish.
- **Opportunities to serve** and grow in faith.
- Friendships and fellowship formed through parish life.
- Access to sacraments and spiritual resources, such as confession and retreats.

¥ Parish Pride

Respondents from all parishes expressed pride in:

- Outreach programs like food banks and support for the homeless.
- Youth and family engagement, including schools and catechesis.
- **Diversity and cultural celebrations** that reflect the universal Church.
- Dedicated clergy and volunteers who lead with humility and love.
