

Alive in the Spirit Dr. Scott Hahn

Jesus will not leave us alone. He won't make us children of God in Baptism only to leave us "orphans," He assures us in today's Gospel (see Romans 8:14-17).



He asks the Father to give us His Spirit, to dwell with us and keep us united in the life He shares with the Father.

We see the promised gift of His Spirit being conferred in today's First Reading.

The scene from Acts apparently depicts a primitive Confirmation rite. Philip, one of the first deacons (see Acts 6:5), proclaims the Gospel in the non-Jewish city of Samaria. The Samaritans accept the Word of God (see Acts 17:11; 1 Thessalonians 2:13) and are baptized.

It remains for the Apostles to send their representatives, Peter and John, to pray and lay hands on the newly baptized - that they might receive the Holy Spirit. This is the origin of our sacrament of Confirmation (see Acts 19:5-6), by which the grace of Baptism is completed and believers are sealed with the Spirit promised by the Lord.

We remain in this grace so long as we love Christ and keep His commandments. And strengthened in the Spirit whom Jesus said would be our Advocate, we are called to bear witness to our salvation - to the tremendous deeds that God has done for us in the name of His Son.


In today's Psalm, we celebrate our liberation. As He changed the sea into dry land to free the captive Israelites, Christ suffered that He might lead us to God, as we hear in today's Epistle.

This is the reason for our hope - the hope that sustains us in the face of a world that cannot accept His truth, the hope that sustains us when we are maligned and defamed for His name's sake.

Put to death in the flesh, He was brought to life in the Spirit, Paul tells us today. And as He himself promises: "Because I live, you will live."



1380-1444 | FEAST DAY - MAY 20

his renowned Italian preacher was canonized only six years after he died. He was born near Siena and studied at the university there. He was ordained a Franciscan priest in 1404. From 1417 until his death 27 years later, he crisscrossed northern and central Italy as an itinerant preacher who drew enormous crowds by focusing on honest and penitential living and on reverence for the holy name of Jesus which led to the spread of this devotion. He also preached against gambling and materialism and turned down three requests to become a bishop.




A young musician told the reporter that the best compliment he ever received came in a magazine review of his work in which he was compared to his father, a famous musician and composer. After a favorable comparison, the writer referred to him as a chip off the old block. The young man felt he had indeed inherited his father's genius for music.

In giving some final instructions, Jesus describes the unity between the Father and Him, and between the Father and the Holy Spirit. That unity is shared with all those who believe in Jesus, because Jesus dwells within them and they in Jesus. Nothing can separate us from the Lord because we share the same life, the same love and the same Spirit. Our unity is more than a superficial likeness; we truly are soul mates of the Lord.

Faith is not something we do as much as it is something that we are. Baptism does not simply make us members of a group called Church. It makes us church, shaping us as a new creation and a child of God. Made in God's image and likeness, we have inherited His genius for life, grace, truth and peace. We are given the same mission as Jesus to build the Kingdom, to proclaim God's love and to share His blessings and His glory. We are given the promise of eternal life with God in Heaven. We are more than chips off the old block. We are heirs of God.






