



Kingdom of Priests

The words God speaks to Israel in today's First Reading are intended for us as well.





In the Church, we have been gathered as the new "Israel of God" (see Gal 6:16). He has made us his own people, the flock He tends, as we sing in today's Psalm.

Moses was Israel's first shepherd (see Ex 3:1). With the Promised Land in view, he prayed that God raise up a successor so that God's people would not be left as sheep without a shepherd (see Num 27:17).

These same words are used in today's Gospel to describe Jesus' pity for the crowds, who are "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd."

Israel's shepherds—the Pharisees and scribes—had abandoned and misled the people through their hypocrisy and spiritual blindness (see Mt 23:1-36; Jer 50:6).

But God had long before promised that He himself would come and save His sheep—searching over the whole earth where they had been scattered "for lack of a shepherd" (see Ez 34:1-24).

Jesus is the new Moses and new David promised by the prophets, a divine shepherd-king sent to restore God's priestly kingdom (see Jn 10:11).


As Moses commissioned Joshua as his successor, so we see Jesus today giving the Twelve His powers and authority (see Mt 9:35; 10:1). In God's plan, they are to seek out the lost sheep of Israel first and then bring all nations into the fold (see Acts 13:46; Rm 1:16).

Together we have been saved and reconciled to God, as we hear in today's Epistle. As he delivered Israel, he has also made us a kingdom of priests in the Church (see Rev 1:6).

So we come in this Mass to serve Him with gladness, to praise His kindness, which endures forever

Juneteenth Observed Monday, June 19

Mass times at Our Lady of Victory 8:15am and 12:15pm



The Parish office is closed.

Juneteenth (short for "June Nineteenth") marks the day when federal troops arrived in Galveston, Texas in 1865 to take control of the state and ensure that all enslaved people be freed. The troops' arrival came a full two and a half years after the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation. Juneteenth honors the end to slavery in the United States and is considered the longest-running African American holiday. On June 17, 2021, it officially became a federal holiday. Juneteenth 2023 will occur on Monday, June 19.

Saint Juliana of Falconieri

I uliana was the only child of a wealthy couple in Florence, Italy, who had built the church of the Annunciation there. She refused to marry and was enrolled as a tertiary with the Servite order; her uncle, St. Alexis Falconieri, was one of the seven founders of the Servites. For nearly 20 years, Juliana lived a devout and useful life at home. In 1304 she formed a community of tertiary sisters who devoted themselves to prayer and good works in Florence. She is considered the foundress of the Servite community of nuns, and was canonized in 1737.


Fathers Day

Nativity of John the Baptist

FIRST CENTURY FEAST DAY: JUNE 24

This feast marks his exceptional birth to the aged priest Zechariah and the equally aged and barren Elizabeth. The angel Gabriel announces his birth in a vision to Zechariah, who hesitates in believing and is struck mute until eight days after John's birth. Then, Zechariah, in a beautiful canticle that ends the first chapter of Luke's Gospel, proclaims that John "will be called prophet of the Most High." John's eventual beheading is commemorated with an Aug. 29 feast. A patron saint of Canada and Jordan, John is also the patron of Florence and the Knights Hospitaller of St. John.
