The ideal candidate will be passionate about inclusive education, possess strong leadership skills, and have a deep understanding of special education practices and regulations.

Overview of responsibilities:

- 1. Develop and oversee the implementation of service plans for students enrolled in the REACH Program, ensuring that goals are tailored to each student's unique needs and abilities.
- 2. Collaborate with teachers, support staff, and parents to create learning environments that promote academic, social, and emotional growth for students with special needs.
- 3. Conduct regular assessments to monitor student progress, adjust instructional strategies as needed, and ensure compliance with state and federal special education laws.
- 4. Serve as a liaison between school administration, students, parents, teachers, and outside agencies to facilitate communication and coordinate support services.
- 6. Coordinate and participate in meetings, including service plan meetings and student support team meetings, to develop comprehensive plans for student success.
- 7. Stay informed about current research, trends, and developments in the field of special education, and integrate this knowledge into program planning and implementation.
- 8. Collaborate with families to work on transition plans after high school.
- 9. Create and implement a peer mentor program for our students.
- 10. Teach special education classes as needed or any other duties requested by administration.

- Bachelor's degree in Special Education, Education, or a related field (Master's degree preferred)
- Valid state teaching certification in Special Education
- A strong understanding of inclusive practices and accommodations
- Demonstrated leadership skills, including the ability to mentor and support colleagues
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to build positive relationships with students, families, and colleagues
- Strong organizational skills and the ability to manage multiple priorities effectively
