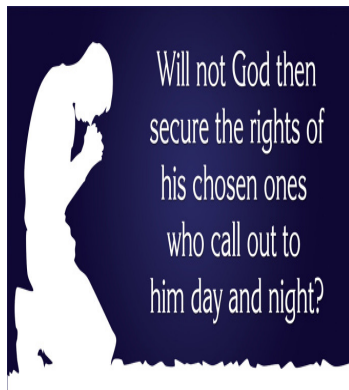

Don't You Know Me? – Part 3

Jesus asks His own disciples, the ones He has traveled with, eaten with, rested with, and lived with for the last three years the question of who He is. Don't *they* know Him? He's heard what others are saying about Him. But asks His disciples, "What about you, who do *you* say that I am?"

The thing about this is that it's not merely answering a question correctly. Peter does that when he answers by saying that Jesus is the Christ of God. That is a correct answer, a true fact. But what Jesus is asking His disciples, and what He asks each one of us is: what *am* I to you, what do I mean to you personally, what kind of relationship do you and I have?

Jesus isn't after factual knowledge. He's after personal knowledge, the kind of knowledge people have with those they love, like members of their families. When Jesus asks you and me "Who do you say that I am?" we could answer by saying, "well, the Council of Chalcedon determined that you are God Incarnate, that you're truly God and truly Man. And the Nicene Creed says that you're the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten not made, consubstantial with the Father." And we'd be correct.

But Jesus might well look us square in the eye and say, "yes, but even those are the words of others. Who do you *yourself* say that I am? Don't you know Me?"

You could have a PhD in New Testament studies. You could be able to pass any scholarly examination the most brilliant minds on earth could come up with about Jesus Christ. You could have read every book on Christology ever written and still not know Jesus personally.

In his second letter to Timothy, Paul does not say, "I know what I have believed" but rather he says, "I know *whom* I have believed".

Of course the Nicene Creed and the documents of the historic Councils of the Church are necessary. They stand as proclamations to the world about the Gospel and what the Church stands for. But the Christian faith is more than reciting a creed. It means knowing a Person: Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

And how do we do that? How do we come to know Jesus ourselves, as someone we know and love, like a trusted friend, or a parent or sibling?

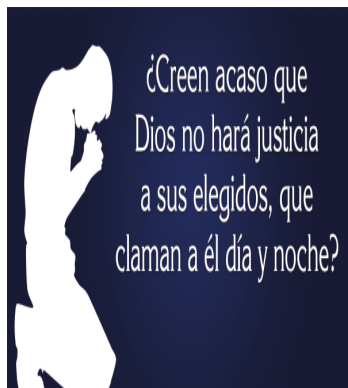
Actually it's not something that we ourselves *make* happen. It's something we *let* happen. Jesus comes to us. He is always there waiting for us to look to Him, to pray to Him, to hear Him. He stands at the door of our hearts and knocks. He doesn't smash the door down with a battering ram. He desires only that we open up to Him and invite Him in. We let Him in. And when we do, we come to know Him as He knows us and as He wants us to know Him. Like someone you would be pleased to have dinner with. Like someone who belongs in your home, someone you would want to be that close to you. Like someone you love.

That is who Jesus wants to be for each one of us. And that is how He wants you and I to know Him. Amen.

No me Conoces? - Parte 3

Jesús pregunta a sus propios discípulos, con los que ha viajado, comido, descansado, y vivido los últimos tres años la pregunta de quién es El. No lo conocen? Ha oído lo que otros están diciendo acerca de El. Pero pregunta a Sus discípulos, “Y ustedes, quien dicen ustedes que soy?”

Lo extraño de esto es que no se trata solo de contestar una pregunta correctamente. Pedro hace eso cuando contesta diciendo que Jesús es el Cristo de Dios. Esa es una respuesta correcta, un hecho verídico. Pero lo que Jesús está preguntando a Sus discípulos, y lo que nos pregunta, a cada uno de nosotros es: qué soy yo para tí, qué significa para tí personalmente, qué clase de conexión tenemos?

Jesús no quiere datos objetivos. Quiere saber hechos personales, la clase de hechos que la gente tiene con los que aman, como los miembros de sus familias. Cuando Jesús nos pregunta (a tí y a mí) “Quién dices tú que soy yo?” podríamos responder, diciendo bueno, el Consejo de Calcedonia determine que Tu eres Dios Encarnado, que eres verdadero Dios y verdadero Hombre. Y el Credo Niceno dice que eres Hijo Unico de Dios, eternamente engendrado del Padre, Dios de Dios, Luz de Luz, Dios verdadero de Dios verdadero, engendrado, no creado, de la misma naturaleza del Padre.” Y estaríamos en lo correcto.

Pero Jesús podría vernos directamente a los ojos y decir, “sí, pero esas son aún las palabras de otros. Quién dices, tú mismo, que soy yo? No me conoces?”

Podrías tener un doctorado en Estudios del Nuevo Testamento. Podrías pasar cualquier examen de erudición que las mentes más brillantes del mundo pudieran inventar acerca de Jesucristo. Podrías haber leído cualquier libro escrito sobre Cristología, y aún así no conocer a Jesús personalmente.

En su segunda carta a Timoteo, Pablo no dice, “Se lo que he creído,” sino que dice, “se en Quién he creído!”

Por supuesto, el Credo Niceno y los documentos de los históricos consejos de la Iglesia son necesarios. Se mantienen como proclamaciones al mundo acerca del Evangelio y lo que la Iglesia significa. Pero la fe Cristiana es más que recitar un credo. Significa conocer a una Persona: Jesucristo como salvador y Señor.

Y cómo hacemos eso? Cómo llegamos a conocer a Jesús nosotros mismos, como a alguien que conocemos y amamos, como a un amigo fiel, o un padre o un hermano?

En realidad no es algo que nosotros podamos causar. Es algo que dejamos que suceda. Jesús viene a nosotros. Siempre está ahí, esperándonos que le busquemos, que recemos, que lo oigamos. Está parado a las puertas de nuestros corazones y toca. No derriba la puerta con un ariete. Desea solo que le abramos y lo invitemos a pasar. Lo dejamos entrar. Y cuando lo hacemos, llegamos a conocerlo como El nos conoce a nosotros, y como quiere que le conozcamos. Como a alguien con quien disfrutarías una comida. Como a alguien que pertenece en la casa, alguien que quisieras tener cerca. Como a alguien que amas.

Eso es lo que Jesús quiere ser para cada uno de nosotros. Y así es como El quiere que tú y yo lo conozcamos. Amén.

2018-2019 Fiscal Year.

We are working on the statistics for our fiscal year that ended 9/30/2019. We had another amazingly blessed year.

We assisted families with food and/or financial needs 9589 times.

We distributed 207,300 pounds of food. USDA puts the value of this donated food at \$346,191.

We distributed \$8500 in clothing that was donated to us and \$8000 worth of adult and infant diapers.

We distributed \$2670 in furniture, household goods, fans, and heaters donated to us.

Al I together, donated items that went directly in aid totals \$365,361. This does not include monetary assistance for bills.

The Autobiography of Saint Therese of Lisieux – The Story of a Soul translated by John Beevers is about a young French girl born in 1873 to highly religious parents and died a Carmelite nun at the age of twenty-four in 1897 following a slow and painful fight against tuberculosis.

Therese was born into an obscure middle class family in a small provincial town where she led an uneventful life. There was nothing remarkable about her intelligence and she was very shy and moody. She was received into the local Carmelite order in 1889 at the age of fifteen and took her final vows in 1890 where she joined her four biological sisters who also became nuns.

In the words of Pope Pius XI, "St. Therese attained supernatural gifts in such an abundant way that she was able to point out the sure way of salvation to others" and it is in *The Story of a Soul* that she points out this way. A month before she died Therese told her sister Pauline, "What I have written will do a lot of good. It will make the kindness of God better known."

St. Therese's "little way" is that of trusting in Jesus to make her holy and relying on small daily sacrifices instead of great deeds and on a complete and unshakeable confidence in God's love for us. In many ways she is the patroness of finding holiness through everyday life.

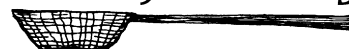
This confidence means that we cannot be afraid of God even though we sin. He will instantly forgive us and come to meet us but we must repent and realize that God's love never fails.

Therese was canonized by Pope Pius XI in 1925, a mere twenty-eight years after her death and was named a "Doctor of the Church" in 1997 by Pope John Paul II. Another book you may enjoy is

St. Therese of Lisieux – Essential Writings by Mary Frohlich which will enlighten the mind, nourishes the spirit and challenge the conscious. St. Therese of Lisieux spent her final nine years in a Carmelite cloister in Lisieux, France. Therese is probably best known by the title "The Little Flower" a name she gave herself. She compares herself to a humble little flower in a meadow, not one of the gorgeous ones but one of the ordinary little flowers who praise God simply with their ordinary beauty.

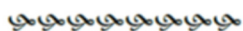

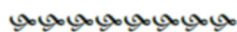
