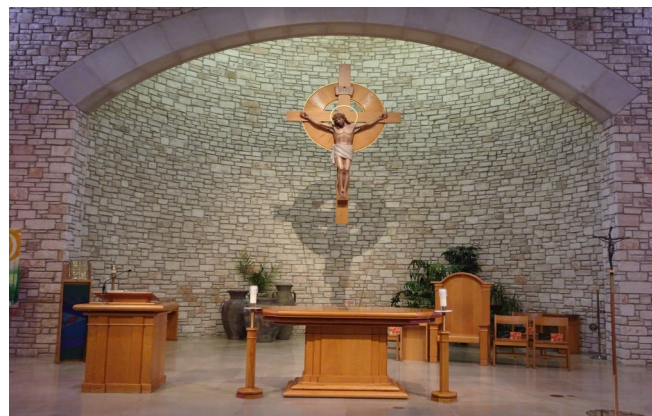

MESSAGE FROM FR. DAVID

Are We Living in the End Times? Part 9

Here are some teachings from the Catechism on the topic of the End Times. In Parts 10-11, I will comment on this teaching of the Church. 675-679 are the paragraph numbers from *The Catechism of the Catholic Church*.

The Church's ultimate trial

675 Before Christ's second coming the Church must pass through a final trial that will shake the faith of many believers. The persecution that accompanies her pilgrimage on earth will unveil the "mystery of iniquity" in the form of a religious deception offering men an apparent solution to their problems at the price of apostasy from the truth. The supreme religious deception is that of the Antichrist, a pseudo-messianism by which man glorifies himself in place of God and of his Messiah come in the flesh.

676 The Antichrist's deception already begins to take shape in the world every time the claim is made to realize within history that messianic hope which can only be realized beyond history through the eschatological judgment. The Church has rejected even modified forms of this falsification of the kingdom to come under the name of millenarianism, especially the "intrinsically perverse" political form of a secular messianism.

677 The Church will enter the glory of the kingdom only through this final Passover, when she will follow her Lord in his death and Resurrection. The kingdom will be fulfilled, then, not by a historic triumph of the Church through a progressive ascendancy, but only by God's victory over the final unleashing of evil, which will cause his Bride to come down from heaven. God's triumph over the revolt of evil will take the form of the Last Judgment after the final cosmic upheaval of this passing world.

II. TO JUDGE THE LIVING AND THE DEAD

678 Following in the steps of the prophets and John the Baptist, Jesus announced the judgment of the Last Day in his preaching. Then will the conduct of each one and the secrets of hearts be brought to light. Then will the culpable unbelief that counted the offer of God's grace as nothing be condemned. Our attitude to our neighbor will disclose acceptance or refusal of grace and divine love. On the Last Day Jesus will say: "Truly I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me."

679 Christ is Lord of eternal life. Full right to pass definitive judgment on the works and hearts of men belongs to him as redeemer of the world. He "acquired" this right by his cross. The Father has given "all judgment to the Son". Yet the Son did not come to judge, but to save and to give the life he has in himself. By rejecting grace in this life, one already judges oneself, receives according to one's works, and can even condemn oneself for all eternity by rejecting the Spirit of love. *To be continued . .*

From your Librarians

Books to borrow from the Notre Dame Parish Library, located in the Pastoral Center are available Mondays & Wednesday 10:00 AM - 12:00 Noon. For the next two months, we are selecting books that recognize the poor souls in purgatory, saints and the coming advent and Christmas season.

The Secrets, Chastisement, & Triumph of Two Hearts of Jesus and Mary by Kelly Bowring is a book about the end of the world. It's about hope, renewal, about the time we are living in, which is a time of crisis and upheaval that will lead to divine renewal. This book is about heavenly prophecy and preparing for what is to come upon humanity. It chronicles how the divine prophecies of our times will unfold and second, it is a call to prepare to answer the heavenly call of Our Lady to her spiritual children to assist her in crushing the head of Satan. Our best response is to confirm whose side we are on by acts of conversion, consecration, and reparation to the Lord.

The Triumph of the Immaculate Heart by Janice T. Connell is a gorgeous colored picture book that was consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and is dedicated to the Lord Jesus Christ, King of all Nations. The book is divided into three parts: part one is Vision (the Apparitions: Reign of Love, and Victorious Queen of the World), part two is Pilgrims Prepare (included in this section are visits to places where our Holy Mother was seen, (Paris, Lourdes, Lisieux, Fatima), part three is the Pilgrim's Triumph with visits to Prague, Russia, Poland, and The World. As The Blessed Virgin Mary said in Fatima on October 13, 1917, "In the end my Immaculate Heart will triumph. Russia will be converted and a period of peace will be given to the world". A wonderful good that encourages us to remember how powerful the Blessed Mother is. **33 Years in the Holy Land** by Fr. A.G. Sertillanges describes how Jesus conducted himself at each stage of His life – in childhood, in His hidden life in Nazareth, in His life of prayer and preaching, in His interactions with men, both friends and enemies, and in His relation to the whole universe. This author writes in a style that unites the stories in the Gospels to the peculiar circumstances and geographical surroundings in Christ's life. These stories will bring vividly to life those secret and holy places sanctified by our Lord.
