Books to borrow from the Notre Dame Parish Library, located in the Pastoral Center are available Mondays & Wednesday 10:00 AM - 12:00 Noon. **Is Jesus Coming Soon?** by Ralph Martin, makes clear that Catholics should understand what the Scriptures and the Church really teach about the return of Jesus. The truths about the Lord's return and the "last things" are intended to have a radical impact on our daily life and help us live in the joy, freedom, and love of the Holy Spirit. This book will help you look at the confusion and opportunities of the years ahead with discernment and confidence. The Woman and the Way by George T. Montagne, S.M. tells us that Mary knows Jesus better than any other human being. Looking at the Savior's life through the eyes of Mary, you can appreciate more your own call to become like Him. By developing a

<u>Mary for Today</u> by M. Basil Pennington, O.C.S.O. explores the mystique surrounding Mary by delving into Scripture, Vatican II documents, and recent apparitions and private revelations. If you are interested in developing or enriching your relationship with Mary, this book is for you.

A Pathway Under the Gaze of Mary is the biography of Sister Maria Lucia of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, O.C.D. Sister Lucia along with her cousins Francisco and Jacinta Marto were visited by an angel of the Lord three times in 1916 and six times by Our Lady in 1917 who asked them for prayer and penance in reparation and for the conversion of sinners. Francisco died at the age of 10 and Jacinto died at the age of 9, both were canonized in 2017, the 100th anniversary of Mary's first appearance at Fatima. Sister Lucia continued to live until she was 97. Her special mission was to consistently spread devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary as the soul of the message of Fatima. This book will give you a better perspective of Sister Lucia's daily life, spirituality and writings, and provides testimonies that mirror the depth of her soul. Written by Deborah Harris
