

Verse to reflect on this week:

I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me, because I live and you will live. On that day you will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you.





On May 14<sup>th</sup> we venerate the memory of the 13<sup>th</sup> Apostle – St. Mattias. He was the one who God chose to replace Judas who took his own life. This moment reminds us that the church from very first moments has had different challenges to face. An interesting fact that we learn from Saint Luke, author of The Acts of the Apostles, is that this decision has been made by Peter and his brothers even before the Pentecost. The Apostles, united in prayer, listen to God's voice and choose someone to replace Judas, who was no longer with them.

It's hard not to be sentimental for me, because that very day in 2005 I was ordained with my classmates as a priest at Saints Peter and Paul cathedral in Gliwice. God is still choosing his imperfect sons to follow his voice and proclaim the Good News of Eternal Life. I would have never imagined leaving Poland at that point and traveling to the other side of the world. Undoubtedly, God's plans are different from ours and God's dreams are bigger than ours. His love and patience are never tired and He never quits.


During these 18 years since my ordination, I've learnt that the best way to follow God is not be brave or learn new languages or continue your theological education (these elements are important, though). The best way to follow God's voice is to be quiet and humble, and meditate constantly on his unimaginable love for us.

Every one of us in invited to create (daily) a very personal relationship with Jesus Christ and to listen to Him. It is easy for us to be caught up with our plans and visions and neglect or even avoid His direction. I feel like a number of times I did or said something that didn't come from Him. The biggest regret I have, though, is that I haven't spent more time with him and haven't loved him more.

Thank You Notre Dame parishioners for praying for me. I wouldn't have thought that one day I will be preaching the Gospel so far away from my homeland in a beautiful village in a *Hill Country*. Again, God's dream are so much bigger and so different from ours.


