Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

The feast of the Sacred Heart was approved for specified dioceses by Clement XIII in 1765, and extended to the whole Church by Pius IX in 1856. In 1889 Pope Leo XIII elevated it to the rank of first class, and through an encyclical letter in 1899 dedicated the whole Catholic world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.





Behold this Heart which has loved men so much, and yet men do not want to love Me in return. Through you My divine Heart wishes to spread its love everywhere on earth." - Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary

Of all devotions in the Catholic Church, devotion to the Sacred Heart was, and remains, one of the most widespread and popular. The whole month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Throughout the month of June in Poland most of the parishes are having exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (before or after the Mass) and people express their love and dedication to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is held on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost. Devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus are numerous. Some have been explicitly approved and frequently recommended by the Apostolic See. The most popular are: Personal Consecration, Litany to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (approved for the whole Church in 1891), Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart, The Practice of the First Fridays of the month (derives from the "great promises" made by Jesus to St. Margaret Mary - the First Friday devotion contributed significantly to a renewed use of the Sacraments of Penance and of the Holy Eucharist).

Twelve Promises of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary (1673 in Paral-le-Monial, France)

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- 2. I will establish peace in their families.
- 3. I will console them in all their troubles.
- 4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
- 5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
- 9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
- 10. I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
- 12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

The Miracle of Father Kapaun, Priest, Soldier, and Korean War Hero by Roy Wenzl and Travis Heying is about Emil Kapaun who was just an ordinary boy growing up in the small town of Pilsen, Kansas Pilsen was a Czech settlement town where the original residents taught themselves to farm on land that was difficult and unforgiving. The migrants held tightly to their roots. Kapaun worked alongside his family in farming and was an active member of his church, St. John Nepomucene, where he would later preside as priest.

He is a figure whose heroism during the Korean War and as a POW, who died in what was call the Death Hut which was filled with maggots and feces, continues to serve as a lamp to guide our feet on the path of life. We need heroes like Fr. Kapaun teaches us how to live and make decisions in our daily life.

In 1993, Pope Saint John Paul II declared Kapaun a "Servant of God" which is the first step toward sainthood. FYI, Pope Saint John XXIII is the patron saint of army medics and military hospital chaplains. St. M.ichael the Archangel is the patron saint of all the military

Fr. Kapaun's story will inspire you too live your life for God and others and be the saint that God is calling you to be. Father Emil Kapaun was a modern American priest-hero whose unique and inspiring story should be known to every Catholic.
