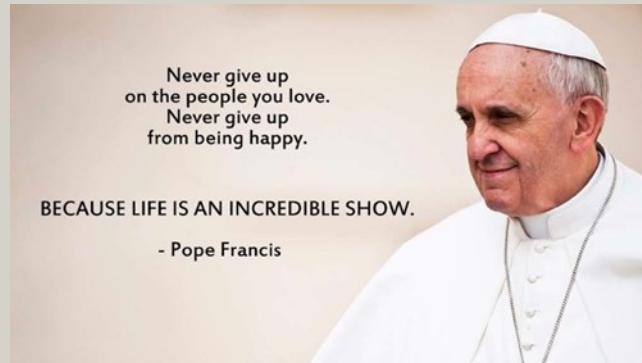


## XII Sunday in Ordinary Time
