



From Your Librarians

This will be the last article on how to better prepare to celebrate the Mass.

Many believers go to mass more and more often without any preparation, like getting there at the last minute when mass is about to start, unprepared to enter into the mystery of the Divine Presence in the celebration. Such a believer is always in danger of considering the Mass as long and boring, of not liking the priest, the sermon, the singing or something else. For the same reason, these believers escape from church as soon as the benediction is given. However, outside they have time to spend with their friends, stop or chat or visit with them and in real life, it is very rare for people to discuss the Word of God that was read that day. If one goes to Mass like this, in a hurry and just to respect the rule, then probably nothing will happen inside them.

Sometimes we have a lack of understanding about the nature of the Eucharist itself. This sacrament means thanksgiving and should remind us that doing Eucharist is more about giving thanks and praise to God for all that He has done for us than it is about receiving communion. Saint Pope John Paul II said in *Dies Domini* "As the whole community gathers to celebrate "the Lord's Day," the Eucharist appears more clearly than on other days as the great "thanksgiving" in which the spirit-filled Church turns to the Father becoming one with Christ and speaking in the name of all humanity. The rhythm of the week prompts us to gather up in grateful memory the events of the days which have just passed, to review them in the light of God and to thank Him for His countless gifts, glorifying Him "through Christ and with Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit."

We go to Mass to replenish our daily lives, which are a continuous struggle against sin. In this struggle the world, the body and the forces of darkness clash with the world of God, the Spirit, love and peace. Our heart is the scene of the clash. From it must light up a sign of victory, a beacon of light for a better world, offering better relations between men and women, insuring justice and peace. Our heart is the place where justice and peace meet and fuse together. But if sin takes control of the heart, only darkness and evil lives.

After Holy Mass, we are called upon to live in the Spirit and to continue the struggle against the limitations of the body. In this struggle for life, there are both victories and defeats, sins are committed and wounds are received. But love and the healing of the wounds are active and effective. So we go to the Mass that Jesus celebrates for us and leave it renewed and ready to go out into the world to be Eucharistic by giving ourselves willingly and joyfully to others.
