#### **Advent Project**



Long-time parishioners may remember when St. Vincent de Paul sponsored a Giving Tree Project during Advent to benefit children in our area. That project has been dormant for a few years because several similar programs exist in the area, some neighbors made multiple requests of vari-

ous agencies and prospective donors often failed to follow through with the requested items. Administration of the program simply became too difficult.

We want to resurrect the project with a bit of a twist so parishioners can show their appreciation for the efforts made by teachers and staff at Notre Dame. This year, we have asked the administrative staff and teachers at Notre Dame Catholic School and the staff in the Notre Dame parish office to prepare "wish lists" of items that will improve their work environment or help them do their jobs better. We hope that parishioners will join in to make these wishes come true. Most everyone agrees that teachers are an invaluable resource and knows they often pay money out of their own pockets to buy supplies needed to provide a first-class educational experience for our children. At the same time, our parish staff works hard every day to facilitate our spiritual growth, build community and serve parishioners in a variety of ways.

We will be placing Christmas trees in the Narthex before the first weekend of Advent (December 2-3) and will be decorating the trees with angel ornaments. Each ornament will describe one of the wishes and identify the person or department who submitted the request. Different colors of ornaments will designate the price range of each item so you can select an item that fits your budget.

Simply pick an ornament from a tree and take it with you to shop in a local brick-and-mortar store or online. When your shopping is done, please wrap items if possible (although some may be too large or awkward to wrap) and drop them at the church office or the school office along with the ornament designating the recipient by Tuesday, December 19<sup>th</sup>. It is not critical that you identify yourself as the gift-giver, but you may do so if you desire.

Mary: A Biblical Walk with the Blessed Mother by Edward Sri, is a study guide but one you will never forget. Sri will allow you to experience an extraordinary pilgrimage through Mary's life and see why she is an essential part of our Faith. You will journey through the biblical narrative of Mary's life and visit the places where key events in salvation history occurred. You will be introduced to the Blessed Mother on a personal level and will see how scripture history and Jewish culture reveal the sorrows, anxieties, and joys Mary would have felt in her heart. Edward Sri will take you on a trip you have never experienced. Believe me.

Home of the Assumption – Reconstructing Mary's Life in Ephesus by Father V. Anthony J. Alaharasan is a fascinating story of what happened after Jesus spoke from the cross before he died. He told John that this Mary was now his mother and John was to be Mary's son and from that hour, John the beloved disciple brought Mary into his home and took her to Ephesus. It includes the events leading up to the discovery of the home which St. John had built for her and explores the traditional belief that it is where the Assumption took place. Fasinating.

A Monastery Journey to Christmas follows the rhythm of the Advent and Christmas journey as it takes place in a particular monestary, a place as small and tiny as Bethlehem itself. Experience a deepening of faith while awaiting the joyful expectation of our Savior in quiet prayer.


