

Advent, Christmas and Epiphany in the Domestic Church:
Activities to Celebrate Catholic Liturgical Seasons, by
Catherine and Peter Fournier gives suggestions for families with children in the US in the 21st century for each of the Advent weeks and special days. Stop by and read page vi, about phasing in a Christian celebration of the season in the midst of the modern world's distracting idols. (I was utterly charmed by the comment that "regular prayer is like flying in a small airplane. You begin to see things from a different perspective.") If it sounds like something you could do, check it out, and return it after Christmas, telling us your own story for us to share next year.

The Essential Advent and Christmas Handbook, a Daily Companion, written by the Redemptorist Pastoral Publication is a book that everyone should own. Everybody knows that Advent is the season of preparation for the coming of Christ into the world and that Christmas is the celebration of His birth. This book gives you a richer experience of these sacred times, whether you are a traditionalist, contemporary, or family unit Pages 124-141 contain the complete traditional meditations of St. Alphonsus Liguori.

The Triumph of the Immaculate Heart by Janice T. Connell is a gorgeous colored picture book that was consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and is dedicated to the Lord Jesus Christ, King of all Nations. The book is divided into three parts: part one is Vision (the Apparitions: Reign of Love, and Victorious Queen of the World), part two is Pilgrims Prepare (included in this section are visits to places where our Holy Mother was seen, (Paris, Lourdes, Lisieux, Fatima), part three is the Pilgrim's Triumph with visits to Prague, Russia, Poland, and The World. As The Blessed Virgin Mary said in Fatima on October 13, 1917, "In the end my Immaculate Heart will triumph. Russia will be converted and a period of peace will be given to the world". What a wonderful good that encourages us to remember how powerful is our Blessed Mother.

The Advent season this year starts on December 3 and ends on December 24.
