

The Desert of Lent 2024

Dear Parishioners,

Our Good Father is giving us again some time of grace: Lent. Every year we take 40 days to prepare ourselves for our Lord's Passion and Resurrection. It is a very personal journey.

Each one of us is called to look (individually) at his life and renew it and refresh it for God. We are God's children and he doesn't want us to get lost on the way to his Kingdom.

Last Wednesday, when the ashes touched our heads, we'd been reminded that we come from dust and that we will turn into dust again. It is important to accept our limitations and temporalities of this life. God wants us to remember that our destination isn't here – it is much higher, it is much bigger, than this world.

I wish for us to have courage to go to the desert this Lent. Let's go to be *there* with Jesus. He is waiting in quietness and solitude. In the desert we will able to listen more carefully to the voices of our own heart.

It is understandable that we can be afraid of the emptiness of the desert. Our loud culture has impacted us and we have gotten used to our noises: texting, calling, emailing, meeting with people. Nevertheless, God is waiting in the silence. Will you try to go there? Will you try to change YOU? It is totally up to you.

Let's pray for each other. Please, pray for me.

#### **40 CANS FOR LENT**




#### CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY CD RELEASE
