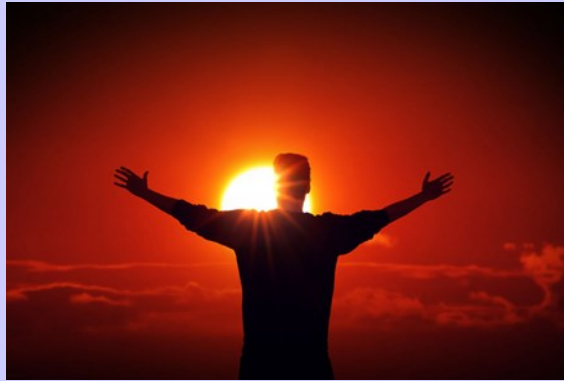

Verse to reflect on this week:

*Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice,
"This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." Suddenly, looking around, they no longer
saw anyone but Jesus alone with them.*



Mark 9:7-8



The Catholic Church undoubtedly has her way of celebrating Lent. On the first two Sundays we see places of solitude and intimacy in the Gospel: the desert where Jesus is in prayer and the high mountain where Jesus is transfigured.

Before we try to jump into the action of changing our lives and our hearts, we need to have a decent amount of time to be really present to reflect and listen. Later, after recognizing what requires a change, we can start to move forward.

God takes time and he isn't in a hurry. He likes stages: like seven days of creation (Genesis 1) or surrendering and conquering Jericho (Joshua 6). God is teaching us that in order to be a better person and create something beautiful in us or to destroy something powerfully destructive in us we need time. Rushing isn't good: we must have a plan.

This weekend we mark the 10th day of our Lenten journey. How are we doing? Are we on the right path? Do we see changes in us? Is God closer to us than on Ash Wednesday (February 14th)? Do we feel more in love and more at peace today?

I hope you are doing well. Be patient and follow God's loving guidance. His plan is always the best.

40 CANS FOR LENT

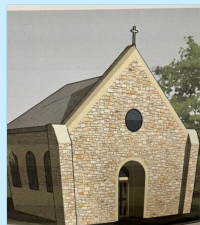

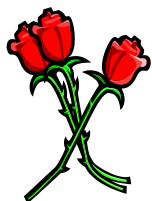
