

He made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace."

While the first two Sundays in Lent are very spiritual and intimate (Jesus' prayer in the desert and Jesus' Transfiguration on the mountain), the third one is very powerful and has a very strong message of cleansing. Jesus couldn't accept things that were being done in the temple area and drove some people out of there.

What does Jesus see when He's looking at my heart and my life? Does He like what He sees? Is He happy with me and my choices?

People from the Gospel were most likely spiritual people who slowly lost their spiritual sensitivity and at some point, disrespected (unknowingly) God's house. It is easy to get lost in the world and justify even the poorest choices.

Maybe this week we can ask Jesus to enter the temple of our heart and allow Him to drive out whatever He doesn't like or approve in us? Maybe this week we will scrutinize ourselves and make some changes that we've been afraid of for a long time?

My heart belongs to God and He wants to be my only King. Would I give Him permission to do whatever He wants and however He wants? We all need some purification – whether we know it or not. Some of the things that we think or say or do are not so great, and we usually know it. God knows best how to make us clean. Let's invite Him to be our only King and surrender totally to Him without any shortcuts. He is the King of Kings and He will come again.

From the RCIA book: "The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong and good.

For the scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth and the life."

What a beautiful Lenten blessing for these Elect, AND all of us as well. Please continue to pray for these coming to the Lord's table at Easter.


