














Prayer for a successful Appeal

Healing Mission

Paul Rymniak is an ordinary man or so he claims. Multitudes will disagree with his self assessment, for he is known throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico and Puerto Rico. He is not a

medical doctor or ordained minister or priest. He says he sees Christ working through him and he says that there is scriptural basis for his work. (Matt. 18-19)

According to Paul who credits **GOD** and NOT HIMSELF for his successes, he possesses several hundred testimonies from many medical doctors and lay people which confirm the Healings. He has been in Ministry, now, for 37 years.

He has a series of tapes which includes the one tape that started his ministry....... THE HEALING ROSARY. With his busy schedule he has written a book about healing called... THE MYSTERY OF HEALING. This book details his life in the healing ministry along with his own personal story of how it all began.

Paul sees is as an honor to be at our parish to conduct his Healing Mission, which will include the ROSARY and the STATIONS OF THE CROSS. Paul will offer his healing efforts to all who seek it.
