



Fire of Love by St. Catherine of Genoa, 5" x 4 ½" in size, less than a 1/4" in depth but filled with the truth about Purgatory. In this book, you will learn about: why we should seriously believe in purgatory, why Purgatory is both a place of sorrow and joy for the soul, how the purifying fires of Purgatory reflect God's love, and how St. Catherine of Genoa's vision of Purgatory can help you face the sorrows in your life with greater faith and courage. Five hundred years ago, Fire of Love transformed the views of Purgatory, revealing these purifying fires to be the glow of God's love. Now is the time to change your own view of Purgatory and discover in them a sweet manifestation of the unfathomable depths of God's Love. St. Catherine of Genoa (1447 - 1510) was a wife, hospital director and a mystic.

The Four Last Things: A Catechetical Guide to Death, Judgement, Heaven and Hell by Father Wade Menezes.

Few things in this earthly life are absolutely certain, but the most undebatable of these is death. Every person, even the atheist, will admit that death is certain. Death, however, is not the last event in this life of ours. Immediately after death, we shall be judged and then again on the Day of Judgment when all humanity will know us for what we are.

Too often the reality of Heaven and salvation are highlighted at the expense of the Church's teachings on Death, Judgment, Purgatory, and Hell. Yet, these important doctrines of the Church hold the truths of salvation — truths that can lead us to Heaven or can pull us away from it. Fr. Wade Menezes, EWTN television host and Assistant General of the Fathers of Mercy, shows us that God has not called us to His wrath, but to salvation. He shows us that Heaven and Hell, salvation and damnation, eternal life and eternal punishment are all complementary doctrines. They need each other to be complete and we must understand the Church's teachings on all of these doctrines in order to have a balanced view of the world. Death, Judgment, Heaven and Hell these are the Four Last Things toward which we are moving each hour of the day and night. Read this book, and you'll have a firm grasp of one of the most important doctrines of Holy Mother Church that holds the truths of Heaven and our own salvation.

November 1 is All Saint's Day – to remember all saints and martyrs & November 2 is All Soul's Day – to commemorate those who have passed away.
