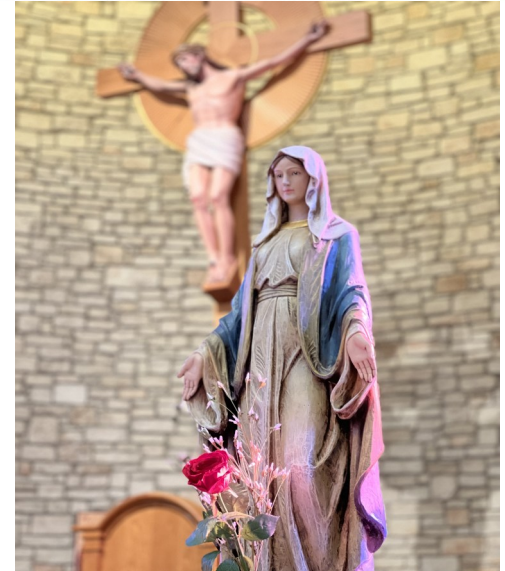

## From Your Librarian

Books from your Notre Dame Parish Library are located in the Pastoral Center and open Wednesday from 10:00 AM - 12:00 Noon. If you are unable to come during these times, please call Deborah Harris at 214-538-9105 and I will help you get the book you need. **Divine Mercy Sunday** was established by St. John Paul II for the second Sunday after Easter and was held for the first time on April 30, 2000 at the canonization that took place on this day of Faustina Kowalska. Pope St. John Paul II died in April 2005, on the vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday, beatified on Divine Mercy Sunday, May 1, 2011 and was canonized together with Pope John XXIII on Divine Mercy Sunday on April 27, 2014. The feast was originally based on the Catholic devotion to the Divine Mercy of that Faustina Kowalska reported as part of her visions of Jesus. According to the diary of Kowalska, the feast of Divine Mercy receives the biggest promises of grace from Jesus in the Divine Mercy devotion. Jesus promised that "The soul that will go to Confession (up to or about 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday) and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion."
