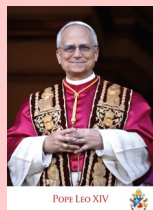

Saint Louise de Marillac – Servant of the Poor by Sister **Vincent Regnault, D.C.** Even today, the birth of Louise's mother is unknown which provided Louise with her first experiences of true poverty, that of having no maternal affection. Her father recognized this and because he loved his dear daughter, confided her care to the Dominican Nuns at the Royal Monastery of Poissy. Louise was thirteen when her father died. She always wanted to become a nun but was denied due to her delicate health so her only choice was to get married. In January 1613, Louise was married to Antoine Le Gras. A son was born in October 1613. Louise's husband died in 1625 and left her and the child with very limited resources. Since moving was necessary, Louise wanted to be near to her confessor and spiritual director Vincent de Paul who was the principal of the College of the Bons Enfants. During this time when Louise was struggling financially, her family was enjoying great royal favoring. Louise accepted this situation because of her deeper spiritual motivation. She would grow to love poverty because of her ever-growing intimacy with Jesus.

In 1633, Vincent de Paul and Louise de Marillac collaborated and found a new community of lay women called the Daughters of Charity. It was very adventurous for a young woman to travel the unsafe and uncomfortable highways of France but Louise was at last certain that God was speaking to her and leading her. The associations were self-governing and the members were called "Servants of the Poor". The governing Rule was drawn up by Vincent de Paul and states: "to honor our Lord Jesus Christ and to serve the poor corporally and spiritually."

Louise de Marillac helped the poor to discover in their misery the loving, watchful tenderness of God, since each of us in particular is called to be His beloved. For Louise, every human distress became a call of God to the better service of the poor. In 1640 as a team, Louise and Vincent de Paul created in France, a whole new method of child care. In 1645, the first infant home in France was built. Three months prior to her death, Louise wrote the following letter to Vincent de Paul, "For a long time now you have sought ways of helping children. I beg our Lord to reveal His holy will in this matter as He does in all other and to grant us the grace of carrying it out faithfully."

Today there are over four thousand five hundred Conferences in the world and internationally almost twenty thousand Daughters of Charity that serve the poor in over ninety countries.

St. Louise de Marillac's feast day was May 9.

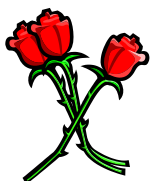
