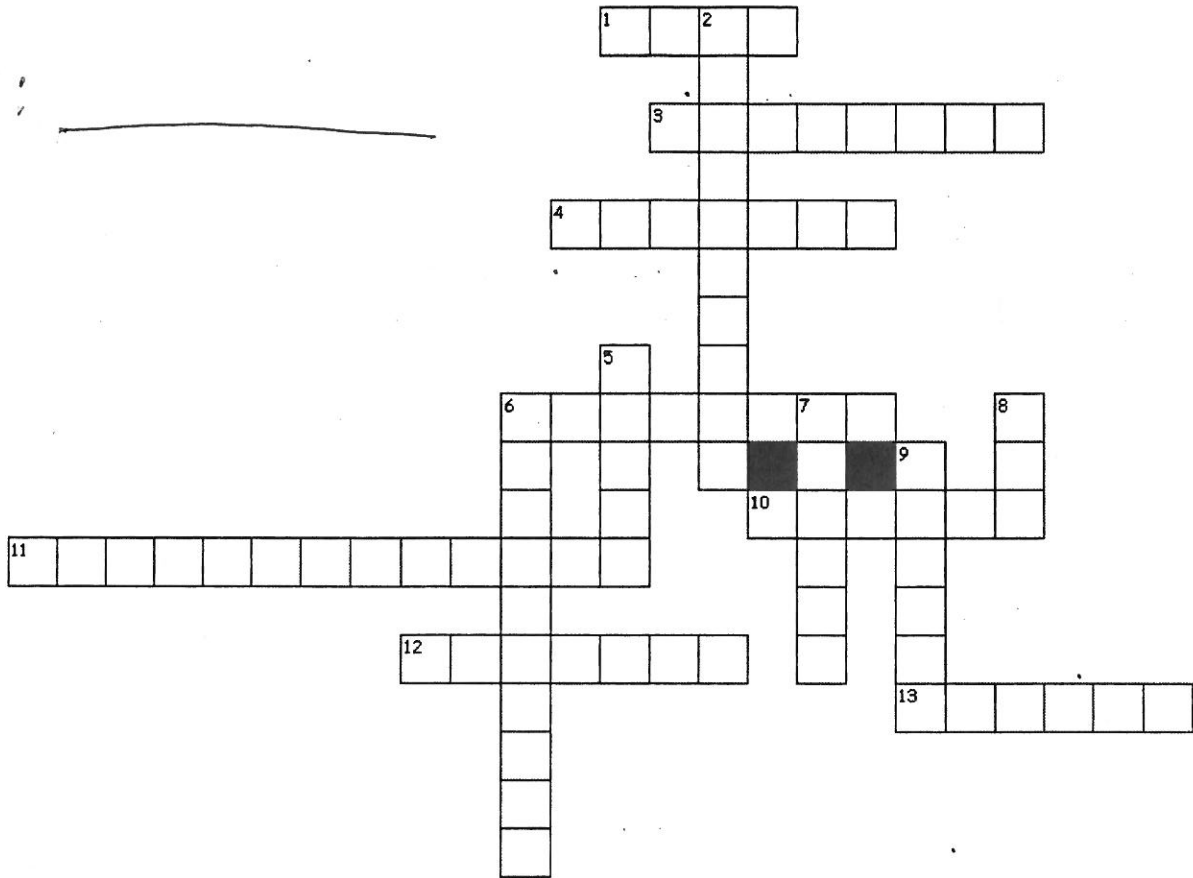


# A Social Justice Crossword
