**CAST RESPONSIBILITIES**

The 8th grade musical is a well-loved tradition at St. Joseph Catholic School. Students will not only learn to be better actors while performing for an audience but they will also participate in the production process. Listed below are the responsibilities expected of you as a cast member of the production.

- ☐ Attend all required rehearsals and performances. Rehearsals will begin on January 6, 2019 with a full day rehearsal on April 28th and show day on April 29, 2019 with two performances (afternoon and evening). Please give advance notice (at least three days) for a missed rehearsal by notifying Ms. Bambino at [g.bambino@sjschoolva.org](mailto:g.bambino@sjschoolva.org) or Jacki Esguerra at [jackiesguerra@gmail.com](mailto:jackiesguerra@gmail.com). In the event of an illness or emergency, please notify Ms. Bambino as soon as possible.
- ☐ Be prepared, ready, and focused for each rehearsal. Arrive ON TIME (early is on time) to all rehearsals, morning or afternoon and be ready to jump right in to rehearsal. Bring your script and pencil to every rehearsal. Have lines, songs and blocking memorized on time for scenes you are scheduled for. A schedule will be released before the start of rehearsals in January.
- ☐ Cell phones should be silenced and put away with your belongings. No texting or calls during rehearsals.
- ☐ Be expected provide costume/costume pieces if necessary.
