"1 o'clock"-

There is ONE God, Creator of Heaven, Earth, things visible and invisible.

Why did the One God create me? To know, love and serve Him in this life & to be happy with Him forever in the next.

The First Person in the One God is God the Father who created us.

Jesus tells us the 1st of the *Great Commandments* is Love God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength.

Jesus Christ is one person.

The Church is ONE because all true members are one in faith, sacraments, and sacrifice and are united under one visible head (Pope)

"2 o'clock"-

The Second Person in the One God is God the Son, who redeemed us (saved, bought us back)

Jesus tells us the 2nd of the *Great Commandments* is "Love your neighbor as yourself"

There are 2 natures in Jesus Christ-the divine nature of God, the human nature of man.

There are 2 kinds of sin- Original sin and actual (personal) sin

There are 2 degrees of sin- Mortal (deadly) sin and venial (lesser sin)- mortal sin drives God out of my soul and venial sin injures my relationship with God

There are 2 kinds of grace- *Sanctifying* (sacramental) grace and *actual* grace. God actually gives Himself to us through Sanctifying grace which can only be received in the Sacraments. By praying for it and obeying God's word, God gives us actual grace which is courage, help, inspiration, assistance, to do good.

"3 o'clock"-

There are **3 Divine Persons in the one God**- This mystery is called **The Trinity**.

The Third Person in the One God is God the Holy Spirit.

There are 3 Theological Virtues- Faith, Hope, & Love (Charity)

There are 3 things necessary for an action to be a **Sin** (Mortal or Venial)

- a. The action must be wrong (seriously for mortal, less serious for venial)
- b. You must know that the action is wrong (seriously or less seriously)
- c. You must freely choose to do it anyway

"4 o'clock"-

There are 4 **MARKS** of the Catholic Church- It is **One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic**- It is One because we all believe the same faith; it is Holy because it's founder and head, Jesus Christ, is holy, it is Catholic because it is universal=(for all people, places, times), it is Apostolic because the apostles spread it and led it, and their successors (bishops and pope) still do.

There are 4 cardinal virtues- Prudence, Justice, Fortitude, Temperance- Prudence means thinking and choosing carefully to do right -Justice means to act justly/fairly towards God and neighbor- Fortitude means courage to do what is right even when it is hard- Temperance means controlling our wants and desires, self-control.
