



# "VIVERE CHRISTUS" AWARD TO DEACON JOE & MARGE BALOUGH Sunday, September 9, 3:30 PM St John Cathedral, Paterson

Bishop Serratelli will confer the "Vivere Christus" Award on several worthy candidates from throughout the diocese on Sunday at a Vespers Service at the Cathedral. Among those receiving this award will be St. Bon's own Deacon Joe and his wife Marge. Congratulations to them on this acknowledgment of their dedication to the life of the Church of Paterson!

The phrase "Vivere Christus" comes from St. Paul's letter to the Philippians and means "To live is Christ." Deacon Joe and Marge have "lived in Christ" for the forty-four years of their marriage and for the almost forty years of their ministry here at St. Bon's. They are the proud parents of Allison who lives in Wayne with her husband Tommy Fierro. In 2016 Joe and Marge became grandparents. Their granddaughter Emily lights up their lives every day for the last two years!

Joe and Marge came to St. Bon's around 1982. Since then they have both been involved extensively in the life of the parish. They were instrumental in initiating the parish's Prayer Group approximately twenty-five years ago. They've led the Group's annual retreat for the last twenty years. The Prayer Group still meets every Tuesday evening in the Tailor Shoppe. Many parishioners remember the efforts in the 1980s and 1990s known as "Refounding" sponsored by the Franciscan Friars of Holy Name Province in every ministerial site on the east coast. It was with great enthusiasm that the pastor Fr. Alvin Faddish O.F.M. engaged all the parishioners to rebuild the life of this local church. Joe and Marge were at the forefront of this effort.

Over the years both Joe and Marge have taken on leadership roles in various ministries and committees. Marge served as Chair of the Pastoral Council of Ministries for several years. She planned several Tricky Tray events and other fundraisers. They both provided education and oversight of the altar servers. They both served as Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers. Joe was ordained to the permanent diaconate in May 1991 and has been faithful to his ministry of visiting the sick and the infirmed, preaching at Mass and teaching with his wife in the Religious Formation program, in the Pre-Cana sessions held at St. Bon's for many years, in preparing parents and godparents for the baptisms of their infants, in preparing adults for initiation in the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) with baptism, confirmation and first Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Their commitment to the life of the parish, to the life of the Gospel, and to life in Christ has been remarkable. They are indeed deserving of the recognition. The witness of their lives has revealed to all of us the reality that "to live is Christ!"
