

#### REGULATION FOR THE LENTEN SEASON

Fasting is required for those 18-59 years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and *abstinence from meat* on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent for those 14 years and older.

*Fasting means* eating only one full meatless meal and two light meatless meals during the day. Fasting also includes no eating at all between meals, although liquids are permitted. *Abstinence means* not eating meat at all that day.

## **FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY**

Due to the snowstorm on Saturday, January 29 we were unable to meet our commitment of collecting and delivering frozen dinners, groceries and used clothing to the Father English food pantry. With the strong probability of further poor weather issues as well as scheduling constraints in the next several weeks, we plan to make our next pickup on Saturday February 26.

As you know, winter is a difficult time of year for many of our struggling neighbors. Increased heating expenses put added stress on already tight budgets. The prolonged cold temperatures of this season have made it even harder. This dilemma forces many in our community to make a hard choice between buying food and turning on the heat. There are parents stuck in low-paying jobs, seniors scraping by on meager Social Security checks, and hardworking single mothers struggling to afford groceries. Many turn to the Food Pantry for help.

*Please, as we go about our lives this month, continue to remember these poor and hungry in our midst and prepare for our next collection of groceries and frozen dinners on Saturday, February 26.*
