FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Our St. Bonaventure community supported the food collection for the Father English Center, on Saturday, August 27th. Contributions included:

30 frozen dinners	19 bags of groceries
15 cartons of canned goods	270 lbs. of rice
60 lbs. frozen chicken parts	
2 bags of used clothing	\$550 in donations

These totals include a \$400 donation to the Community Food Bank of New Jersey for the account of the Fr. English Food Pantry made by our Francis J. O'Byrne Knights of Columbus Council #240 as well as \$150 in donations to the same account made by several generous parishioners.

As we anticipate this month's collection, please remember that those who survive day to day mired in poverty don't wear signs on their sleeves designating them as such. Yet they are among us all the same. In fact 29% of the families in Paterson live below the poverty line. Your donations of food do more than address the physical needs of the poor. They also provide hope to parents who struggle to put food on the table for themselves and their children. Because you care, you also feed their spirit and give them the courage to go on. Thank you for all you do.

Please, as we go about our lives this month, continue to remember the poor and hungry in our midst and prepare for our next collection of groceries and frozen dinners on Saturday, September 24th.
