THE FRANCISCAN FRIARS OF HOLY NAME PROVINCE

More than two hundred Franciscan Friars will gather next week, June 5 to 9, at Siena College, Loudonville, New York for the last provincial gathering of our Holy Name Province. As some of you are aware, the six provinces of OFM Franciscans in the U.S. will become one province in October. Consequently, Holy Name Province will cease to exist. This change should not affect the presence of friars here at St. Bonaventure since the parish has been designated a 'priority ministry' for the new province. The Provincial and leadership team of the new province, Our Lady of Guadalupe Province, will be announced by the Minister General of the Order, most likely in July. The new Provincial Office will no longer be at West 31st Street in New York City; it will be moved to Atlanta, Georgia. Please keep the friars of our province and the other 5 provinces in your prayers as we go through this significant transition.
