FRANCISCAN FEAST DAY ON AUGUST 2ND

Our Lady of the Angels of the Portiuncula

At the foot of the mountain where Assisi is situated, hermits from Palestine built an oratory or small prayer chapel in the first centuries of the Christian era. This oratory together with a small plot of land was given to St. Benedict in the 6th century. The name Portiuncula, that is, Little Portion, is derived from the transfer of this small piece of property. The little church was called St. Mary of the Angels. The people of Assisi went there often to pray.

When St. Francis of Assisi responded to the call of grace to live the life of the Gospel, his first act was to restore this sanctuary of the Queen of Heaven. Many extraordinary favors were granted to him in this little church of the Portiuncula. It is considered the cradle of the Order of Friars Minor. Still a place of pilgrimage and prayer, especially on August 2nd, a plenary indulgence is granted to those who visit this chapel or any Franciscan oratory in the world. A large basilica was built over the chapel. The little sanctuary of the Portiuncula is still preserved in its original condition. St. Francis loved this place so much that he told his friars: "If someone drives you out of this place, leave by the side door and return by the center door, and preserve this space as a holy place in honor of our Blessed Mother."
