THE SYNOD ON SYNODALITY BEGINS

Earlier this month, the Synod of Bishops began on October 4th, the Feast of St. Francis. This year the Synod includes voting delegates who are not bishops. The voting delegates include laypeople; fifty-four voting members are women. This Synod is the fruition of a long process of listening on the parish and diocesan levels.

Available as on our parish website, there is an explanation of the Synod titled "What you need to know about the Synod." I hope you find it helpful. You can also go to the Vatican website (www.synod.va/en.htm). This listening process comes from a renewed recognition that all the baptized have the gift of the Spirit.

There are three questions facing this Synod:

- 1-How can we be more fully a sign and instrument of union with God and the unity of all humanity?
- 2-How can we better share gifts and tasks in the service of the Gospel?
- 3-What processes, structures, and institutions are needed in a missionary synodal church?

Let's be aware! Let's join together in these months of the Synod that the Holy Spirit may guide the laypeople, bishops, and Pope Francis in their deliberations.
