REGULATION FOR THE LENTEN SEASON

Fasting is required for those 18-59 years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and *abstinence from meat* on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent for those 14 years and older.

Fasting means eating only one full meatless meal and two light meatless meals during the day. Fasting also includes no eating at all between meals, although liquids are permitted. *Abstinence means* not eating meat at all that day.

NORMAS DE CUARESMA

Las normas para el ayuno y abstinencia son obligatorias para los de 18 a 59 años miércoles de ceniza y viernes santo. Los viernes durante la cuaresma son días obligatorias de abstinencia desde la edad de 14 años. Las normas del ayuno permiten comer sólo una comida completa y dos comidas más pequeñas que equivaldrían a una sola comida normal. Durante abstinencia no se puede consumir carne.

WEAR VIOLET OR PURPLE

DURING LENT

As a sign of penance, sacrifice, and preparation. At the midpoint of this season — Laetare Sunday (**the fourth Sunday of Lent**) — rose-colored vestments are traditionally worn as a sign of joy. We rejoice at the midpoint because we are halfway through the preparation and anticipate the coming joy of Easter.
