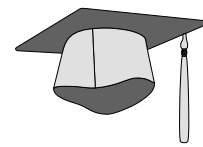

A NEW CHAPTER

Dear Parishioners of St. Bonaventure,

I am humbled and honored to introduce myself as the new Administrator of St. Bonaventure Parish in Paterson, NJ, effective August 1st. I understand that this transition from being administered by the Franciscans to the Diocese may lead to some concern. St. Bonaventure has a profound history as the spiritual home of the Franciscans on the East Coast, being one of the earliest Franciscan parishes in the United States. I desire to journey with you through this transition and pastor our parish into this new era while honoring the rich Franciscan heritage.

I come to you from Notre Dame of Mt. Carmel in Cedar Knolls, a parish that went through a similar transition from the Benedictines to the Diocese nine years ago. As a priest for five years, originally from East Hanover, NJ, my family roots span France, Ireland, and Brooklyn! I am fluent in English, French, and Italian while slowly learning Spanish; please be patient. Before entering the seminary, I was a chef—rest assured, I appreciate all foods except for bad ones! I am a licensed pilot and passionate golfer and love traveling to new places to explore and learn. My seminary education was completed at the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC, and the Pontifical North American College in Rome, where I completed further studies in Seminary

Formation. Additionally, I work with the Order of Malta as a Prison Chaplain at the Morris County Correctional facility.

I eagerly look forward to working alongside Fr. Dan over the next few weeks to better understand St. Bonaventure Parish's needs and history. I acknowledge the fears surrounding all the changes happening in Paterson, but I am committed to listening, learning, and supporting our community throughout this period. This is a renewal period for St. Bonaventure and the whole Church. Together, we will navigate this transition with faith and unity.

UN NUEVO CAPÍTULO

Queridos feligreses de San Buenaventura,

Es un honor presentarme humildemente como el nuevo administrador de la Parroquia de San Buenaventura en Paterson, NJ, a partir del 1 de agosto.

Es fácil comprender como la transición de la administración de la parroquia de los Franciscanos a la Diócesis genera preocupación e incertidumbre. Después de todo, San Buenaventura tiene una historia extensa como hogar espiritual de los Franciscanos en esta costa este del país, siendo una de las parroquias más antiguas de los Estados Unidos. Es mi deseo acompañar esta comunidad durante la transición y guiar pastoralmente nuestra parroquia hacia una nueva era, honrando la rica herencia franciscana.

Vengo a esta comunidad de la iglesia de Notre Dame of Mt. Carmel en Cedar Knolls, la cual también pasó por una transición similar hace nueve años, de una administración de la comunidad Benedicta a la Diócesis. Soy

sacerdote desde hace cinco años y mi origen es de East Hanover, NJ. Mis raíces de familia abarcan Francia, Irlanda y Brooklyn. Hablo inglés, francés, e italiano y estoy aprendiendo español, poco a poco; por favor, tengan paciencia conmigo.

Antes de ingresar al seminario, fui chef – les aseguro que aprecio toda variedad de comidas, excepto las malas. Soy piloto licenciado y golfista apasionado, y me encanta viajar, explorar y aprender sobre nuevos lugares y culturas.

Completé mi educación en el seminario en la Universidad Católica de América en Washington, DC, y la Universidad Pontificia de Norteamérica en Roma, donde realicé mis estudios adicionales en Formación Seminaria. También trabajo con la Orden de Malta como Capellán de Prisión en la Cárcel Correccional del condado de Morris.

Espero con gran anticipación trabajar junto al Padre Dan durante las próximas semanas y poder familiarizarme a profundidad con la historia y necesidades de la Parroquia de San Buenaventura. Estoy al tanto y muy consciente de la incertidumbre y preocupaciones que están generando todos estos cambios que están ocurriendo en Paterson; sin embargo, me comprometo a escuchar atentamente, aprender y apoyar a nuestra comunidad durante este período. Esta es también una oportunidad de renovación física y espiritual para la comunidad de San Buenaventura y toda la Iglesia. Juntos, navegaremos esta transición con fe y unidad.
