
THE MOST HOLY TRINITY


NAACP MID-MANHATTAN BRANCH "PANDEMIC SAFETY" AWARD FOR ST CHARLES, RESURRECTION, AND ALL SAINTS PARISH

St Charles Borromeo, Resurrection and All Saints Parish was selected to receive the distinguished "Pandemic Safety" Award by the Committee on Religious Affairs of the NAACP Mid-Manhattan Branch for being one of the first houses of worship to safely resume in-person services during the Covid-19 pandemic. "You remained deeply planted, steadfast and immovable in your faith; unflappable in spirit; indefatigable in your energy and commitment. Even during the darkest days of the pandemic, you remained a beacon of light. You continued to persevere, to sacrificially give of your time and to give hope to others.....thanking you for your resiliency and heroic efforts in organizing vaccine test sites; distributing food, clothing, face masks, hand sanitizer, covid-tests and other essential personal protective equipment (PPE); and for being innovative in establishing online ministries that were instrumental in helping to combat social isolation and to keeping people connected. For many, you were their only lifeline."

Our Parish will be rewarded at a reception that will be held on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 from 6.00 pm - 9.00 pm at Alhambra Ballroom, located at 2116 Adam Clayton Powell Jr. Boulevard, in Harlem, New York. Parishioners are kindly invited to attend.

Parish Membership – To be considered active members of St Charles Borromeo, Resurrection, and All Saints Parish, each family and single adult must be properly registered and regularly use the weekly donation envelopes or WeShare for our parish. This is the only way the parish can issue documents attesting to parish membership and Catholic practice (e.g. A letter to be a Godparent or Sponsor). Newly registered parishioners must be registered & use envelopes for at least 6 months before a Sponsor Letter can be issued. NOTE: If you are not registered in our Parish, you or your child(ren) cannot receive any of the like Baptism, Sacraments First Holv Communion, or Confirmation.
