

Prostate Cancer Awareness: What Every Man Should Know

Treatment Options

Thanks to medical advancements, prostate cancer treatment options have expanded, offering various approaches to managing and treating the disease:

- **Active Surveillance:** Regular monitoring for slow-growing cancers.
- **Surgery & Radiation Therapy:** Effective treatments that target cancer cells.
- **Hormone Therapy & Chemotherapy:** Often used when cancer is more advanced to slow or stop the growth of cancer cells.

Early screening saves lives, and raising awareness is key. Let's support each other in building healthier futures for our families and communities.



