The Vision of Fr Bryan Massingale for Black Catholicism in the year 2030?

1) Black Catholics will be recognized as key leaders and participants in the struggle to preserve and advance Black human rights in the U.S. in the face of an aggressive assertion of white supremacy.

(This is deeply consonant with the constant call of our popes to be “unconditionally pro-life” and address racism as a pro-life issue.—Cf. Pope St. John Paul II, Pope Francis, and Pope Leo).

2) Black Catholic parishes will be centers of liturgical excellence – renowned for culturally informed preaching and music reflective of the rich diversity of the Black Catholic experience – and innovative hubs for cultivating life-long adult formation for social justice mission.

3) Black Catholic Catechesis will encompass not only traditional Catholic grade and high schools of academic excellence, but also nationally-accessible formats (e.g., Zoom, podcasts or webinars) that utilize the existing and developing pool of Black Catholic expertise in education, the arts, and theology.

4) Faithful to the founding inspirations of the first Black Catholic Congresses and the Federation for Colored Catholics, Black Catholicism will be distinctive for its vigorous commitment to lay leadership development for our institutions, in partnership with Black Catholic clergy and vowed religious.

5) In sum, Black Catholicism will be widely recognized as an essential means for celebrating, promoting and defending Black ability, beauty, talent, intelligence, and holiness in an era of relentless efforts to deny, disparage or denigrate Black humanity and dignity as God’s beloved images.

¿La visión del padre Bryan Massingale para el catolicismo negro en el año 2030?

1) Los católicos negros serán reconocidos como líderes clave y participantes en la lucha por preservar y avanzar los derechos humanos de los negros en EE. UU. frente a una afirmación agresiva de supremacía blanca. (Esto es profundamente consonante con el constante llamado de nuestros papas a ser "incondicionalmente provida" y abordar el racismo como un tema provida.—cf. Papa San Juan Pablo II, Papa Francisco y Papa León).

2) Las parroquias católicas negras serán centros de excelencia litúrgica – reconocidas por la predicación culturalmente informada y la música que refleja la rica diversidad de la experiencia católica negra – y centros innovadores para fomentar la formación adulta de por vida para la misión de justicia social.

3) La catequesis católica negra abarcará no solo escuelas católicas tradicionales de primaria y bachillerato de excelencia académica, sino también formatos accesibles a nivel nacional (por ejemplo, Zoom, podcasts o seminarios web) que aprovechen el conjunto existente y en desarrollo de expertos católicos negros en educación, artes y teología.

4) Fiel a las inspiraciones fundacionales de los primeros Congresos Católicos Negros y la Federación para Católicos de Color, el catolicismo negro se distinguirá por su vigoroso compromiso con el desarrollo del liderazgo laico para nuestras instituciones, en colaboración con el clero católico negro y los religiosos comprometidos.

5) En resumen, el catolicismo negro será ampliamente reconocido como un medio esencial para celebrar, promover y defender la capacidad, belleza, talento, inteligencia y santidad negras en una era de esfuerzos incansables por negar, menospreciar o denigrar la humanidad y dignidad negras como imágenes amadas de Dios.
