## **CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR NEW ARCHBISHOP OF NEW YORK, MOST REVEREND RONALD HICKS**

Our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, has appointed the Most Reverend Ronald Hicks, Bishop of the Diocese of Joliet, Illinois, as the eleventh Archbishop of New York. A native of the Archdiocese of Chicago, where he was ordained a priest and a bishop, Archbishop-designate Hicks has served as Bishop of Joliet since 2020. He will be installed as our new archbishop on February 6, 2026 in Saint Patrick's Cathedral.

Following Pope Francis' death, Bishop Hicks revealed that the Argentine pope "has influenced me extraordinarily throughout my priesthood and my becoming a bishop." He met him three times, he said, and experienced "the love and joy that exuded from him."

Bishop Hicks speaks also Spanish and is considered both a good listener and preacher, very pastoral and compassionate, with a special place in his heart for the poor, according to former parishioners and priests who know him.

Please, pray for Archbishop-elect Hicks. May God bless him abundantly in his new role.

Nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa León XIV, ha nombrado al Reverendísimo Ronald Hicks, obispo de la Diócesis de Joliet, Illinois, como el undécimo arzobispo de Nueva York. Originario de la Arquidiócesis de Chicago, donde fue ordenado sacerdote y obispo, el arzobispo designado Hicks ha servido como obispo de Joliet desde 2020. Será instalado como nuestro nuevo arzobispo el 6 de febrero de 2026 en la Catedral de San Patricio.

Tras la muerte del Papa Francisco, el obispo Hicks reveló que el papa argentino "me ha influido extraordinariamente durante mi sacerdocio y mi conversión en obispo." Dijo que se encontró con él tres veces y experimentó "el amor y la alegría que emanaba de él."

El obispo Hicks también habla español y es considerado tanto un buen oyente como un predicador, muy pastoral y compasivo, con un lugar especial en su corazón para los pobres, según antiguos feligreses y sacerdotes que le conocen.
