ACTIVE NON-VIOLENCE BY DR. KING

We should always remember the message of the living Dr. King, when he addressed a quarter million Americans on the National Mall in 1963:

The whirlwinds of revolt will continue to shake the foundations of our nation until the bright day of justice emerges.

But there is something that I must say to my people who stand on the warm threshold which leads into the palace of justice. In the process of gaining our rightful place, we must not be guilty of wrongful deeds...

We must forever conduct our struggle on the high plane of dignity and discipline. We must not allow our creative protest to degenerate into physical violence. Again and again, we must rise to the majestic heights of meeting physical force with soul force.

Now is the time to stand firm in the nonviolent truth-force of those who've gone before us. We love our nation best by following in the footsteps of those who've worked to make it better.

NO VIOLENCIA ACTIVA POR EL DR. KING

Siempre debemos recordar el mensaje del Dr. King vivo, cuando se dirigió a un cuarto de millón de estadounidenses en el National Mall en 1963:

Los torbellinos de la revuelta seguirán sacudiendo los cimientos de nuestra nación hasta que surja el brillante día de la justicia.

Pero hay algo que debo decir a mi pueblo, que se encuentra en el cálido umbral "que conduce al palacio de justicia. En el proceso de recuperar nuestro lugar legítimo, no debemos ser culpables de actos injustos...

Debemos llevar a cabo nuestra lucha siempre en el alto plano de dignidad y disciplina. No debemos permitir que nuestra protesta creativa degenere en violencia física. Una y otra vez, debemos elevarnos a las majestuosas alturas de enfrentarnos a la fuerza física con la fuerza del alma.

Ahora es el momento de mantenernos firmes en la fuerza de la verdad no violenta de quienes nos precedieron. Amamos más a nuestra nación siguiendo los pasos de quienes han trabajado para mejorarla.

We unite with followers from every church and congregation,

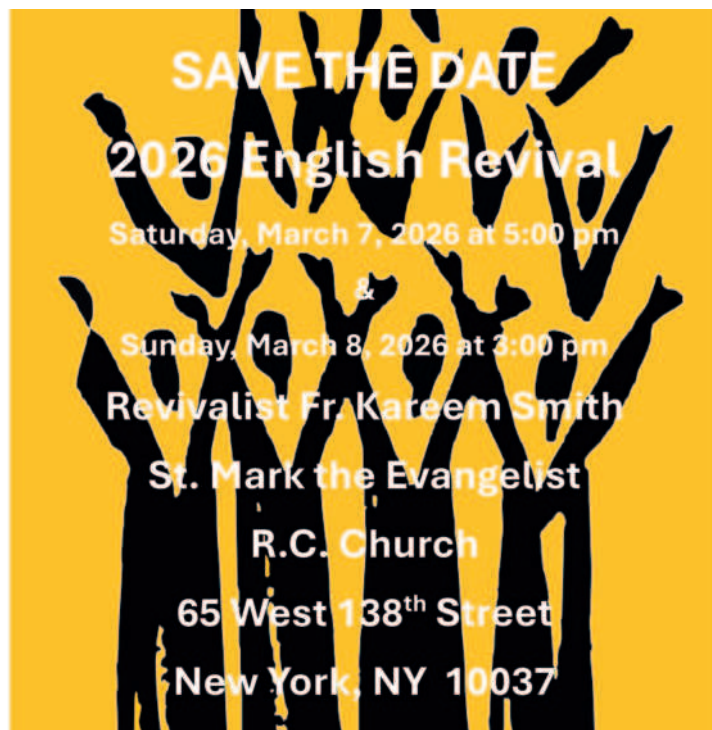
We unite with God's sons and daughters from every creed and culture.
