Pope Leo XIV Proclaims a Special Year of St. Francis

Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed a Special Year of St. Francis, inviting the Church to remember and renew itself as the world marks the 800th anniversary of the saint's death. This time of grace, which continues through January 2027, offers the faithful the opportunity to receive a plenary indulgence.

The Franciscan Jubilee Year officially began January 10 with a decree from the Apostolic Penitentiary of the Holy See and is intended as a gift for the whole Church. Through January 10 of next year, Catholics may obtain the indulgence by celebrating reconciliation, receiving the Eucharist, praying for the Pope's intentions, and making a pilgrimage to a Franciscan church or to a church dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world.

Those who are elderly, sick, or unable to travel may also share in this grace by spiritually joining the jubilee and offering their prayers and sufferings to God. In his proclamation Pope Leo wrote, "In this age, marked by so many seemingly interminable wars, by internal and social divisions that breed mistrust and fear, St. Francis continues to speak. Not because he offers technical solutions, but because his life points to the authentic source of peace."

**Saint Francis, our brother, you who eight hundred years ago
went to meet Sister Death as a man at peace,
intercede for us with the Lord.**

**In the Crucifix of San Damiano you recognized true peace,
teach us to seek in Him the source of all reconciliation
that breaks down every wall.**

**You who, unarmed, crossed the lines of war
and misunderstanding,
give us the courage to build bridges
where the world erects borders.**

**In this time plagued by conflict and division,
intercede so that we may become peacemakers:
unarmed and disarming witnesses of the peace that comes from Christ.
Amen.**

El Papa León XIV proclama un Año Especial de San Francisco

El Papa León XIV ha proclamado un Año Especial de San Francisco, invitando a la Iglesia a recordar y renovarse mientras el mundo conmemora el 800º aniversario de la muerte del santo. Este tiempo de gracia, que continúa hasta enero de 2027, ofrece a los fieles la oportunidad de recibir una indulgencia plenaria.

El Año Jubilar Franciscano comenzó oficialmente el 10 de enero con un decreto de la Penitenciaría Apostólica de la Santa Sede y está destinado como un regalo para toda la Iglesia. Hasta el 10 de enero del próximo año, los católicos pueden obtener la indulgencia celebrando la reconciliación, recibiendo la Eucaristía, rezando por las intenciones del Papa y realizando una peregrinación a una iglesia franciscana o a una iglesia dedicada a San Francisco en cualquier parte del mundo.

Quienes son ancianos, enfermos o no pueden viajar también pueden compartir esta gracia uniéndose espiritualmente al jubileo y ofreciendo sus oraciones y sufrimientos a Dios.

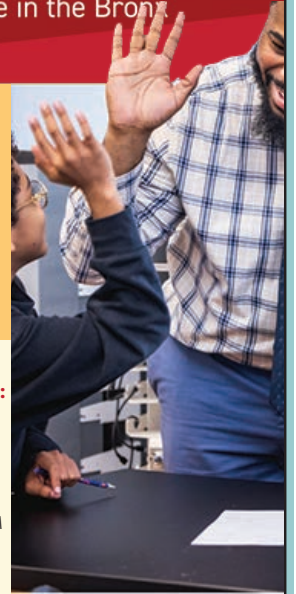
