PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Last Wednesday, I, along with many others from the Presbyteral Council met for a Re-Opening Meeting. There are lots of guestions that are still up in the air. Many of you heard the Governor's Report to re-open churches this weekend. The Diocese looks to not only the State guidelines, public health, the science and medical fields and their data in trying to determine a date. Nothing is set in stone on a date to begin as of yet. Bishop Joensen will be coming out with a statement, if not already, to give us some of the wisdom and data on how we might proceed in the future. I would ask for your patience and prayers during this time. I know it has not been easy. There is no one more anxious in getting back to public masses than myself. I know live streaming is not the same as being here in person. At the same time, we do not want to jeopardize the health and wellbeing of our parishioners either. So, again, I ask for your patience and prayers at this

This is Good Shepherd Sunday. We know that Jesus is the Good Shepherd who lavs down his life for his sheep. Any of us who have worked on the farm or have had to work with sheep know how easily they can go astray and how they need to be corralled or reigned in to prevent themselves from being prey. Sometimes, corrections such as prodding or and I know there are some scholars may dispute this, to break their leg, so they do not go off astray and become prey for other animals. In a sense, we are His sheep, who can easily wonder off the beaten path into sin. He beckons us back with his mercy, forgiveness, and love through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Like a teen-ager who gets grounded, or we are given a ticket for speeding, sometimes, correction is needed for each of us to bring us back. We do not like it. It is painful, but we know it also leads us to a deeper relationship with Him, if we heed his warning. Such a warning might be this coronavirus. We have had to step back, reflect, consider priorities, and be less concerned with the material things of life and more focused on faith and family. It has not been easy at all. When this is all said, done, and over, we will see God's hand and the blessings that may have come our way during this most challenging time.

As the Coronavirus has official taken precedence in Iowa. We are all feeling the effects of this from our workplace to even at home.


