PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Last week, the diocese made some adjustments in regards to the regathering guidelines. Here are the updated guidelines:

- 1. Parishes are now permitted to have up to three servers assist at Mass. This assumes that other mitigation practices (such as mask use and social distancing) are being followed.
- 2. Parishes are now permitted to conduct collections via pole basket (again assuming proper mitigation practices).
- 3. Parishes must clean and disinfect worship spaces, and other parish facilities minimally once a week, and after any confirmed positive COVID test.
- 4. In regards to music, parishes are permitted to have small scholas up to 4 people. This will begin on Palm Sunday. However, no permission is given to have a choir.
- 5. Parishes will be allowed to have up to 100 people for social gatherings.

I would like to take this time to implement these new guidelines this weekend, with the exception of number 4 (unless we have some members of the same household singing). Mask requirements will still be in place unless one is in the role of giving a presentation, singing, or as a lector during Mass and only for the particular times when is singing or speaking. All other times, one needs to be masked up, which includes myself. I hope this helps. I am grateful for all of your cooperation in these efforts and I can trust that the members of St. Thomas Aquinas and Immaculate Conception will use common sense in following the guidelines. 
