

Religious Education and Catechesis of the Good Shepherd parents,

Several items

1. Our faith formation year begins next **Wednesday**, **Sept.** 6 with a **potluck** from 6:00-7:30 pm. The children can visit their classrooms, see who is in their class and meet their teachers.

We will provide sloppy joes, lemonade and water, plates, cups, tableware and napkins. Please bring a dish to share or a free-will donation (suggestion of \$5 per adult and \$2 per child). We need you to RSVP by this Friday, September 1, so we know how much food to prepare. The families who have RSVP'd so far are listed below.

The potluck is for the families who have children in both Wednesday sessions and the Sunday CGS sessions.

- 2. The **8th grade parents** will have a meeting with JoAnn from **7:00-7:30 the night of the potluck (Sept. 6)** to go over the new curriculum for 8th graders this year. We have a 5-session curriculum on relationships spread throughout the year (relationships between God, others and oneself) and want parents to know what will be presented and discussed.
- 3. We will have a meeting in mid-October for the First Communion parents.
- 4. If you are putting together your calendar for the year, our first regular sessions begin on Sunday, Sept. 10 from 9:00-10:00 am for the Sunday group and on Wednesday, Sept 13 for the Wednesday sessions, 5:30-6:40 and 7:00-8:10. We'll meet at regular class time the remaining Wednesdays and Sundays in September.
- 5. On Wednesday, October 4, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, ALL sessions (Wednesday and Sunday) will meet from 6:00 to 7:00 pm (hopefully, outside if the weather allows). We'll have a skit, a police K-9 demonstration, blessing of the animals (bring a picture of your pet) and ice cream.

The Sunday CGS group will not meet on October 8. We will meet every Wednesday and Sunday until Thanksgiving break. There is no RE-CGS on Wednesday, Nov. 22, nor Sunday, November 26.

We will meet for three Wednesdays after Thanksgiving (Nov. 29, Dec. 6 and Dec. 13). The Sunday sessions will meet Dec. 3, 10 and 17.

We resume in **January** on Wednesday, **Jan. 10** and Sunday, **Jan. 14**. And every Wednesday and Sunday after that. On February 14, Ash Wednesday, all sessions will meet for Mass at 7:00 pm.

There will be no RE-CGS during spring break which includes Sunday, March 10 and Wednesday, March 13

Our last day of Religious Education is Wednesday, April 24.
