#### VI. Covid

#### VII. Community building/sustaining

- We discussed videos of parishioners saying why they come to Mass or serve the parish – will need help to get the videos done, we can't leave this on the staff to complete.
- Danielle is working on a project for a marketing class that she will post on Facebook and maybe the website soon to gather information on what is the most important thing the parish provides for them.
- In February, the Archdiocese will be mailing every household in the Archdiocese a survey re: parish viability. Comments from these surveys will be summarized and sent to each pastor/PLC.
- It was recommended that we wait to make decisions on community building efforts once we get some information back from these surveys, that may give us a better direction for discussion.
- Danielle submitted an application to be an FCA volunteer to see how she can become a part of that group within our communities and help share the Catholic faith. Consider other young adults that could serve in this role as well.
- Altar Server training will happen in February (for Urbana and Vinton) and in March (for Walker). We hope that this will bring more families back to Mass if their child is scheduled to serve. Our roster may not be very large. If that's the case, Marcia is recommending that in order to not burn out the youth we do have, to only schedule each to serve once every 6 weeks or so. This is how we are scheduling volunteers for Children's Liturgy in Urbana and Vinton.

 People's level of participation will give us an indication of how important various aspects of parish life are to them. Ex – we are only having Coffee & donuts following Sunday Masses when someone signs up to host.

# VIII. PLC report

- ArchdioceseOne
  - The Archdiocese began sending emails and putting info on Facebook for this fundraising appeal today. The local effort in our parishes is scheduled to take place August 13-October 16. More information will be coming.
- Synod survey
  - o Is scheduled to be sent out by the Archdiocese the first week of February. A paper copy will be mailed to each household. There will also be a link to complete the survey on-line. The Archdiocese is hoping most will complete on-line so as to make compilation of the data easier.
  - Marcia will be encouraging everyone to fill out this survey and give candid responses.
  - Survey is designed to help the Archdiocese assess what makes for a viable parish; how to determine which parishes should be clustered, merged or closed; and how many parishes one priest or PLC can reasonably serve.
