A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time September 1, 2019

"My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God.... For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

The old testament teaching and the parable in the home of the Pharisee offer a great challenge. The first sin listed in the capital sins is pride. The first recorded sin in Genesis can be traced to pride. Our society today seems to make us try to be better than the next person, stronger than another nation, richer as we try to get ahead. Where is humility?

Humility is a forgotten virtue. What do I have that is not gift? What have I received that I did not deserve? What have I offered to someone else in need? A prayer, prayed daily by Cardinal Merry De Val, is known as the Litany of Humility. Find it on goggle and prayerfully reflect upon it and you too will be 'loved more than a giver of gifts'.



Grades K -10: Sundays, starting 15 mins before each Sunday Mass, and finishing 30 mins after each Sunday Mass

SK Faith Formation classes are offered after ALL Sunday Masses.

We continue to provide a Mass-centered program for all grades this year. The program consists of a 15-minute lesson in the church, followed by Mass as a family. Students then move to their classrooms for a half-hour lesson, while parents enjoy hospitality in the gathering space.

Following the guidance of Bishop Serratelli, and along with more and more of the parishes in the Paterson Diocese, we are employing this model which teaches our children and reminds our families that the Mass and Eucharist are the most important part of our Catholic Faith--"game day", if you will.
