Brother Martin <u>sophomore</u> and SBS alumnus Joseph J. Aguda III scored a perfect 36 on the ACT. Joseph took the test for the first time as a Duke Scholar, when he was recognized nationally, and again April 2016. Joseph is the son of SBS teacher Dulce and Joseph J. Aguda, Jr.

"Since 7th grade, my education at Brother Martin has been the cornerstone of my scholastic achievements. My teachers have helped me, my peers have challenged me, and my friends have supported me. Along with my family's support and encouragement and my spiritual formation at St. Benilde, I feel blessed to have reached this point, and I'm looking forward to what the future holds," stated Aguda.

Nationally, while the average number of students earning a composite score of 36 will vary from year to year, on average, less than .04 percent of those students who take the ACT earn the top score of 36. The ACT includes tests on English, math, reading, and science. Each test is scored on a scale of 1 to 36. A student's composite score is the average of the four test scores.
